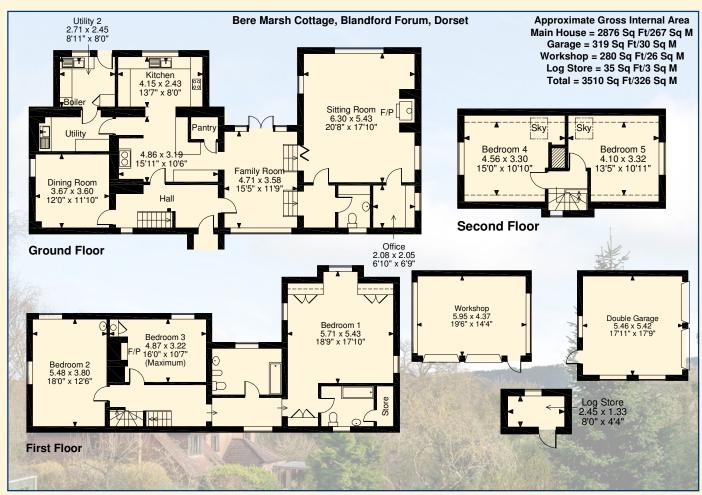

Bere Marsh Cottage is situated on the outskirts of the village of Shillingstone. The property enjoys a quiet rural location yet benefits from excellent communication links. Shillingstone benefits from a real village community. The Church Centre also operates as a Post Office two days a week. The neighbouring village of Child Okeford has an excellent range of amenities including a shop with a café and post office, two public houses, doctors' surgery, primary school, organic shop and church. The larger centres of Poole, Dorchester and Salisbury are all about 20 miles away.

Education The area is renowned for some excellent schools including Clayesmore, Milton Abbey, Bryanston, Sandroyd, Knighton House, Hanford and the Sherborne Schools, together with very good state schools at Blandford and Sturminster Newton. Poole and Bournemouth are within an hour's drive and offer off-shore fishing, sailing and water sports.
