Trade again dearer with all ewes very wanted and probably up £5 per head on the week. Not too many grazing ewes forward but the ones on offer would all have been £70 plus. Best Suffolk Mules £125 plus and best Mules £105 plus. Top today at £140 for a pen of four smart Texels from Mr N Rottenbury of Heasley Mill with £131 to Blue Faced Leicester from Messrs Lucas & Ridge of Chulmleigh. Other Texels again from Mr Rottenbury realised £130 with two pens at £129 from Mr R Richards of Heasley Mill being Suffolk Mules and Blue Faced Leicesters, he also sold another pen of Suffolk Mules at £127.50. £125.50 to Mr Rottenbury's third pen of Texels with three pens at £125; the first to Suffolk Mules from Devon Farming Ltd of Bratton Fleming; the second to Texel crosses from Mr GS Brown of South Molton and the third to Llevn crosses from Messrs PJ & BJ Millman of Chulmleigh. £124 to Suffolk crosses again from Mr R Richards with £123 and £120 twice to other blackfaces from Mr GS Brown. £119 to Texel crosses from Devon Farming Ltd again closely followed at £118.50 to Mules from Mr GS Brown again.
