1361 PRIME LAMBS A really solid number entry for the week in between as expected but best Christmas and New Year with the sale starting at 1.00pm crosses from Mr MTD Pile of Dunkeswell. 39kg Charollais and finishing at 5.15pm. Overall a very mixed entry of lambs forward with a lot of very thick lambs on offer. Trade was slightly easier for the medium and the heavy 108 STORE LAMBS weight lambs as they were predicted harder to sell. Abattoirs are reporting slower sales than expected with also more lambs about than forecast. The heavy lambs look like they could become harder to sell with large catering outlets reducing orders whilst the medium weight lambs (42-46kg) should remain in strong demand. Top today at £145.50 to 63kg Charollais crosses from Messrs GE & EJ Nicholls of West Anstey with £144.20 to 58.6kg Texel crosses from Mrs M Tapp of South Molton. £142.50 to 55kg Charollais crosses from Mr R Irwin of Kings Nympton with same weight Suffolk crosses from Mr MTD Pile of Dunkeswell at £141.50. 58.5kg Suffolk crosses from Mrs FE Tucker of Twitchen realised £140 with £137.50 to 52kg Charollais crosses from Mr JR Wescott & Son of Willand. Closely following at £137.20 was 57kg Texel crosses from Messrs Cook Partners of Georgeham. 57.5kg Texel crosses from Mr KA Hill of Bideford hit £137 with their second 56kg Charollais pen following at £136.80. 63kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs Roberts & Phillips of Dulverton at £136.50 with £136 to 57.3kg Texel crosses from Mr MJ Hooper & Son of South Molton. £135.50 to 60kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs DL & JM Bray & Son of Knowstone with two pens at £135; the first to 54.6kg Dorset crosses from Mr DJ Govier & Partners of Chulmleigh and the second to 58kg Suffolk crosses from Mr LJ Ley & Partners of Goodleigh.

Best pens hit 287ppk to 43.5kg Texel crosses from Mr D Fergie of Ash Mill with 279ppk to 44.2kg Charollais crosses from Messrs GF & PJ Warne of Umberleigh. 41.3kg Texel crosses from Messrs CP & CA Guscott of Dulverton realised 278ppk with 277ppk twice; the first to 41.2kg Charollais crosses from Messrs RJ & AR Snell of further information Burrington and the second to 45.2kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs A & C Rowland of Bampton. Three pens at 276ppk; the first to 39kg Texel crosses from WJD Ltd of Molland; the second to 42.4kg Charollais crosses from Mr RC Huxtable Ltd of Bickleton and the third to 42kg Charollais crosses from Messrs SP Wallis & D Bowden of Ilfracombe. Another three pens at 275ppk; the first to 40kg Charollais crosses from Mr W Milton of Chapelton;

A smaller entry of store lambs than previous sale however they met another very strong trade for all presented. Plenty of buyers around the ring and a number going away empty handed. Top of the day at £115 to Texel crosses from Mr M & Mrs L Gardiner of Ash Mill with £110.50 to other Texel crosses from Mr MJ Hooper & Son of South Molton. £98.50 to whitefaces from Mr CJ Campbell of Woolacombe and £93 to Texels from Mr D Fergie of Ash Mill.

598 CULL EWES & RAMS

Larger entry of cull sheep this week following last weeks very fast trade. Trade overall slightly easier but not much which, considering the number forward was very heartening. All buyers in attendance and all keen to secure ewes. Best trade for the bigger, stronger sorts with a lot of the medium ewes also meeting plenty of demand. Grazing ewes are still wanted despite the changing weather. Best Suffolk Mules this week all over £115 mark and best Mules £105 plus. Topping the day at £144 to a cracking Texel ram from Mr MJ Hooper & Son of South Molton with other Texels from Mr CJ Hagar of Ashreigney at £133 twice and £124. Best ewes to £137 for Blue Texels from Messrs Tester & Edwards of East Anstey with £135 to Suffolk Mules from Mr GC Thomas of Burrington who also sold Texels to £134. £133.50 to Suffolk crosses from Messrs JR, RA & RD Stanbury of Knowstone with £130 twice; the first to Texels from Messrs AJ & MJ Tarr & Son of West Anstey and the second to Suffolk Mules from Messrs Eastman & Bolt of High Bickington. Texel crosses from Devon Farming Ltd of Bratton Fleming at £129 with other whitefaces from Mr L Spry of Parracombe at £128.50. Messrs Tarr's second Texel pen hit £126 with £123 to a Lleyn from Mr R Irwin of Kings Nympton. £122.50 to Charollais' from Mr D Smith of Chulmleigh with £121 to Suffolk Mules again from Devon Farming Ltd. £117 to Suffolk Mules from the Tarr Family this time with their other Texel crosses at £116.50.
