1235 PRIME HOGGS

A decent number of hoggs forward for the first market of 2022, although a few less than last week. Overall a good quality entry with a lot more heavy hoggs on offer this week. Trade as expected very similar to last week with the export types very similar money and the heavies just a shade dearer on the week. All buyers in attendance and all still keen to secure hoggs. Best trade for those 42 -46kg, well shaped hoggs which all buyers were looking for. The well fleshed heavy types were also more sought after this week by all buyers. The buyers are also still looking for the "lighter, fattening" hoggs and we even had a couple pens of store hoggs which met a decent demand. Topping the day at £161 to a pair of 66.5kg Suffolk crosses from Mrs M Tapp of South Molton with 62.6kg Charollais crosses from Messrs DJ & LM Stephens of Oldways End at £159.50. £156.50 to 58.3kg Texel crosses again from Mrs M Tapp with £154.80 to 61.3kg Texel crosses from Messrs DW & J Jones of Heasley Mill, who sold a superb run of 121 hoggs. 58.5kg Charollais crosses from Mr S Stentiford of South Molton hit £152 with a 74kg Texel cross pen from Mr NA Cooke of Torrington realising £150. 57.6kg Charollais crosses from Mr G Mills & Partners Ltd of Witheridge at £148 with 56kg Suffolk crosses from Mr CN Williams of Withypool at £144.50. £143.50 and £143.20 to 55.6kg and 56kg Texel cross pens again from the Jones Family with £140 twice; the first to 60kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs Parsonage Farms of Chulmleigh and the second to 66kg Suffolks from Mr G Mills & Partners Ltd again. £138.50 to 53kg Charollais crosses from Messrs Irwin & Sons of Mariansleigh closely followed at £138 three times; the first to 59kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs AD & SM Bray of Knowstone; the second to 52.6kg Texel crosses again from Mr CN Williams and the third to 56.7kg Charollais crosses from Mr J Haydon of Ash Mill.

Best pens peaked to 283ppk twice; the first to 40.3kg Suffolk crosses from Mr SA Willis of Prixford and the Charollais crosses from Mr RP Williams of Winsford with Son of Chulmleigh.

A double at 275ppk being 39.6kg Charollais crosses from Messrs AW & SA Meikle of Meshaw and 46.2kg Charollais crosses from Messrs PJ & BJ Millman of Chulmleigh. Four pens at 274ppk; the first to 37.6kg Charollais crosses again from Mr SA Willis; the second to 42kg Charollais crosses from Mr GR McLeod of Swimbridge; the third to 43.6kg Texel crosses again from Messrs CP & CA Guscott and the fourth to 45.4kg Texel crosses from Messrs JR, RA & RD Stanbury of Knowstone.

355 CULL EWES & RAMS

Another solid number of cull sheep this week and again a top quality entry with a lot of stronger ewes on offer. More buyers in attendance this week and trade probably a few pounds per head dearer than last week. Best trade for those 1st quality, big framed ewes although it is fair to say all the ewes were wanted. Not too many grazing ewes on offer this week but buyers still looking for them. Best Suffolk Mules all £125 plus and best Mules £110 plus. Best ewes peaked to £142.50 for a pair of Suffolk crosses from Mr NJ Sharland of Braunton with £139.50 to another pair of Suffolks from Messrs HJ & RH Mildon of Brayford. Texels from Mr FR Chave & Son of Cruwys Morchard at £139 with £137 three times: the first to Suffolk crosses from Messrs BR & IB May of Burrington; the second to Texel crosses from Mrs M Tapp of South Molton and the third to Charollais' from Mr R Irwin of Kings Nympton, who also sold a pen of Lleyns at £134. £133 to two pens of Suffolk Mules from Mr DJ Govier & Partners of Chulmleigh and Mr R Metherell of Torrington. Suffolk crosses from Mr NA Cooke also of Torrington at £131 with Texel crosses from Messrs Irwin & Sons of Mariansleigh at £130. £129.50 to Messrs Mildon's second pen of Suffolk crosses closely followed at £129 to second to 41kg Charollais crosses from Messrs GF & PJ Mr NA Cooke's second pen of Texels. £128.50 twice; the Warne of Umberleigh. Four pens hit 280ppk; the first to Mules from Mr NJ Barrow of Brayford and the 41.2kg Texel crosses from Messrs Roberts & Phillips of second to Suffolk crosses from Mr NJ Sharland again. Dulverton; the second to 45.4kg Texel crosses from £127.50 to Suffolks again from Mr DJ Govier & Partners Messrs IFJ & JC Harris of Sheepwash; the third to 44.6kg with £127 twice; the first to Texel crosses again from Charollais crosses from Mr SJ Murrin & Son of Messrs Irwin & Sons and the second to Mules from Monkokehampton and the fourth to 45kg Texel crosses Messrs Parsonage Farms of Chulmleigh. Best rams from Mr CN Williams of Withypool. 279ppk to 44.5kg peaked to £127.50 for a Charollais from Mr GD Fuller &
