A good entry of tegs forward, especially for the time of year met a strong trade on the day. Highest demand for the lighter hoggs which really looked a serious trade, several hill-bred tegs under 38kg soaring past 265ppk mark.

**Auctioneer's comments:**

Wow what a flyer! A fantastic show of all types of cattle from the very best strong cattle to shapely show potentials to some plainer longer-term cattle with frame. We do have a very good range of buyers at Brecon with some looking for cattle in real store order and some for native breeds as well as the excellent show of continentals forward. It is a credit to all vendors for bringing them out in such good order.

Store Steers sold to £1780 (twice) for a 21-month Limousin x Steer (685KG) from RG, BM & RN Jones and also for a 655KG Limousin Steer (22 month) from DE Thomas & Co. The top 10 cattle were all over £1640 per head. Per kilo top price was 394.9ppk for a 10-month Limousin x Steer (390KG) to £1540 from DE & G Davies & Sons. Also, to 378.90ppk for a 9-month British Blue x Steer (355KG) to £1345 from JAV Mills & Son. The top 10 Steers were all over 353ppk.

Store Heifers sold to £1990 for a 20-month Limousin x (540KG) from ER & ME James. Also, to £1950 for a 480KG Limousin Heifer (16m) from the same home. The top 10 Heifers were all over £1750 per head. Top ppk was 425.40ppk for a 355kilo Charolais x Heifer (9 months) from JAV Mills & Son to £1510. The top 10 Heifers were all over 366.30ppk.

A run of fantastic Limousin Steers and Heifers (22/23 months) averaged 296.52ppk and £1548.06 per head from WCR Cooke & Sons. A run of 41 Steers and Heifers (8-10 months) from JAV Mills & Son averaged 333.64ppk and £1301 per head. There were many other excellent runs of cattle which sold to an excellent trade.

**Auctioneers Comments:**

A good entry of 83 TB restricted cattle met at good trade with six purchasers present. The cattle over 450 kilos are the easiest sold and the closer to finish the better the price ppk and per head. Overall, the store steers averaged £1151 per head selling to £1255. The store heifers averaged £1010 per head up to £1275. Some Holstein Bulls 11-13 months (265-360kg) sold from £120 to £450 per head. All vendors happy to be able to sell cattle under the transparent auction system.

If you are down with TB, give us a try. We would advise that cattle should be 400 kilos to be sold within a TB restricted sale. This is due to most purchasers looking for a quick turnaround as they go indoors to AFU units.

A top call of £5350 was among a number of highlights at McCartneys Sale of show Potential calves at Brecon on Saturday (12<sup>th</sup> February).

Hitting the top note at £5350 was Pure Gold, a Limousin X Charolais heifer from Colin and Wendy Phillips, Weobley, Herefordshire. This one is by the herds stock bull Ballyrickard Pluto, a private purchase from Ireland and is out of a homebred cow which has been shown as a calf at the Royal Welsh Winter Fair. She sold to Messrs W P and J M Pritchard, Norton Cannon, Herefordshire, with plans for flushing.

Second top at £5000 was another heifer, this time Tyisaf Sweetpea from Phil and Tracey Jones and family Erwood, Builth Wells. Sired by Garnedd Oatabix and out of Tyisaf Octavia, this pure-bred Limousin heifer stood first in her class and found a new home with Colin Harris, Torrington, Devon.

Following her closely at £4800 was Dai Brute and family, Brecon with a British Blue x Limousin heifer Now You're Talking. This is the second heifer to be offered out of the successful show calf producer Brutus Cheeky Girl and sold to R G Davies, Leicester.

Then at £4500 came Starlight, a Limousin x British Blue heifer from mother and daughter team Wendy Morgan and Caryl Howells, Llandeusan, Carmarthen. By the family's stock bull Garnedd Notice, this one took second place in the pre-sale show and sold to Sean Marsh, Dover, Kent.

A £4000 call the secured the reserve heifer and reserve overall champion, Blackberry from the Lewis family, Llanwrda, Carmarthen. This one is by the British Blue Sire, Dragon Blues Firefly and full sister to Dream Girl who won the Royal Welsh Show in 2018. She was knocked down to previous buyer Colin Harris.

Close behind was a £3900 sale for the sole entry from the Joseph family, Llyswen, Brecon a British Blue cross heifer, Blueberry. Paying this money for a blue and white roan heifer was local buyers W T Morris, Brecon.

And then at £3850 was the champion from the pre-sale show under judge Paul Tippetts, Shifnal, Shropshire. Tango is a Limousin cross heifer by Beulah Jurassic and out of a Limousin Dam and was bred by Rob Jones and family, Builth Wells, Powys. She now joins the Foxhill Livestock show team of Michael and Melanie Alford, Cullompton, Devon.

Messrs Mills, Llanafan Fawr, Builth Wells then took £3750 for their best of the day, a Limousin cross heifer out of a British Blue cross cow. She was knocked down to Phil and Sharon Sellers, Lincoln.

Top priced bullock of the day and top price in the un-haltered section was Omicron a Limousin x British Blue from L J and G V Rea, Dursley, Glos. This one is by the AI sire Lodge Hamlet and sold at £3600 to join previous purchases of Colin Harris.

Next up in the steer section was Red Alert, a Limousin cross from D G and E Lewis, Plumsaint, Carmarthen. This one was taken at £2550 by D Thomas, Lampeter.

And then came champion steer a British Blue cross by Cromwell Fendt from the Rea family, vendors of the top priced steer. At £2000, he joined the trailer back to Kent with Sean Marsh.

Commentating on the sale, auctioneer Jenny Layton Mills said heifer trade was incredibly strong with what she believes to be a record heifer average of more than £2700.00
