948 PRIME HOGGS

actually dearer than last week for both the handy Hoskin, Bishops Nympton. weight (42-46kg) and the heavier (47kg+) hoggs. Most hoggs up £2-£3 per head on the week. Very difficult to predict next weeks trade with lots of hoggs coming forward in the North of the country. It is also noticeable that we are beginning to find more scaled up hoggs each week. Top call of £150.50 for 4 67.5kg Texels from FJ Sing & TGJ Avery of Marians*leigh* with other pens to £145 for a 67kg Charollais from MTD Pile, Dunkeswell. A 65kg Texel X from AE Chudley & Son, Romansleigh achieved £144.50, whilst 3 65.3kg Suffolk X from PJ Berry of Eastacombe reached £144. 65kg Texels from JC Webber, Burrington met with a pleasing £143, whilst 67kg Texels from JO Yabsley, Little Yeo met with £141. 59.5kg Charollais X from AJ Dart, Chulmleigh were rewarded with £140.20, and a 60kg Charollais from D Smith, Chulmleigh made £139.50. £138.50 was achieved twice, firstly for 62kg Close Wool from AW & SA Meikle of Meshaw, and then for 60kg Texels from JC Webber, Burrington. A 57kg Texels from AE Chudley & Son, Romansleigh made £135.50, with 58kg Suffolks From MAF Roberts & AL Phillips of Dulverton closely behind at £135.20.

Top price of 278ppk for 31 45kg Texel X from KA Hill of Bideford, with 44kg Suffolks from JWJ Milton, West Anstey up to 276ppk. 14 45.5kg Charollais from EJ Westaway, Newton Tracey made 273ppk, with 40.9kg Charollais from K Luckett, Rackenford at 272ppk. 4 pens to 271ppk, firstly for 43.2kg Easy Cares from MW & SE Woolridge, Burrington, then for 40.7kg Texels from K Luckett, Rackenford, then for 45.5kg Charollais from GF & PJ Warne of Umberleigh, and finally for 44.6kg Texels from DW Phillips of Berrynarbor. 2 pens to 270ppk, firstly for 20 43.7kg Charollais from EF Thorne of Tawstock, then for 25 42.6kg Charollais from Beer Bros of Warkleigh.

A decent number entry although fewer than the Another small entry of spring lambs this week but a previous fortnight. A very mixed entry this week with definite lift in the trade and it was noticeable that a a lot of smaller lots and few real runs of hoggs. number of buyers are now looking for the new season Overall quality was less than last week and again a lambs as the quality of the hoggs reduces. Top call large proportion of heavy hoggs on offer. Trade was 295ppk or £123.80 for 2 42kg from Lucie

79 STORE HOGGS

A similar number entry to two weeks ago with trade probably slightly easier. Definitely fewer buyers looking for the smaller and very lean hoggs now as the season comes towards its end. Best trade for the stronger hoggs which will not take too long to finish. Store Hoggs topped at £96 for Charollais X from JC Isaac of Rackenford. Also to £80 for Charollais X from the same home. £77 for Zwartables from Ravenhill-White of Chittlehampton, and to £75 for Charollais X from G Webster, Umberleigh.

340 CULL EWES & RAMS

A smaller entry than last week but again a decent number forward for the time of year. The quality was not that of last week although there were still a good amount of big ewes on offer. Trade very similar to last week if not a touch dearer for some of the bigger ewes. All buyers in attendance and all keen to secure ewes. Trade likely to remain until the end of the month. After which it is likely to ease. Best Suffolk Mules this week £150 plus and best Mules £125 plus. Top price was for a strong Charollais ewe from A & S Hoskin, Bishops Nympton at £209! Texel X from RJ, GM & AJ Tucker, High Bickington to £178. A Suffolk f rom Mildon & Ley made £160. 10 Suffolks from RF Jones of Heasley Mill met with an impressive £159, whilst a single Suffolk from AJ Dart of Chumleigh achieved £154.50. Also from RF Jones were 14 Suffolks to £154. White Faces from GJ & SM Down, High Bickington achieved £151, with a Suffolk X from G Webster of Umberleigh at £150. 7 Suffolk X from FJ Sing & TGJ Avery of Mariansleigh achieved £149.50. Best of the rams to £138 from D & J Baker, Yarnscombe for a Charollais. Texels from FJ Sing & TGJ Avery, Mariansleigh at £137 with three Texels from T & L Cole, Heasley Mill at £132.50.
