600 SPRING LAMBS

A bigger number forward again this week which included some lovely runs of fresh young lambs. Trade back a little on last week with most lambs back £3-£4 a head. Not so many buyers keen to procure the lambs this week with the Bank Holiday looming, and so many hoggs still being sold. There is still the unknown about how many hoggs are left to be sold but it is likely more abattoirs will be looking for the lambs in the coming weeks. Although the SQQ was down on the week, it should be noted that a majority of the lambs presented were at the heavier end of the SQQ (42-45kg), where buyers are preferring 38-41kg new season lambs. R Iwrin, Kings Nympton topped the ppk with 41kg Charollais at 323ppk. 40.4kg Suffolks from Lucas & Ridge, Chumleigh to 322ppk, and also 41.3kg Texels from G Mills & Partners Ltd, Witheridge who sold another super run of over 200 lambs. 40kg Texels from MH Gillbard, Puddington to 319ppk. 3 pens to 318ppk, firstly 41.5kg Suffolks from G Mills & Partners Ltd; 40kg Suffolks from R Irwin; 41.5kg Charollais from G Mills & Partners Ltd. 3 pens to 317ppk; 41kg Charollais from G Mills & Partners Ltd, 41.4kg Charollais from the same home, and 39.5kg Texels from FJ Sing & TGJ Avery, Mariansleigh. This reinforces the demand for the 38-41kg new season lambs.

Top call of £132.80 for 41.3kg Texels from G Mills & Partners Ltd, Witheridge. 41kg Charollais from R Irwin, Kings Nympton closely behind at £132.50. 42.5kg Charollais from Eastman & Bolt, High Bickington to £132.20. 5 pens to £131.80, firstly for 45kg Charollais from RS, EJ & RL Ash, North Tawton, then for 41.5kg Suffolks from G Mills & Partners Ltd; 44.8kg Charollais from FG & LA Nott, Meshaw; 41.5kg Charollais again from G Mills & Partners Ltd; 41.8kg Suffolks again from the same home. 2 pens to £131.50; Suffolks from G Mills & Partners Ltd at 42.5kg, and Charollais from the same home at 41.6kg

1098 PRIME HOGGS

Another bigger than expected entry and again a very large proportion of heavy hoggs (over 50kg) forward, and a lot of really heavy (over 60kg) forward. Trade as expected slightly dearer again for the handy weight hoggs (42-46kg) and again slightly dearer for the 47-51kg hoggs. Trade much the same as it has been for the over 52kghoggs, although there was a bit more life in the trade for the 'super' heavies (over 65kg) with a number of these realizing over £145. Plenty of buyers still wanting the hoggs although most wanting the quality handy weights that are becoming scarce!

Also from RH & GA Morrish Ltd were 69kg Charollais to £139. 66kg Charollais from J & J Watts, Goodleigh to £138, with 66kg Suffolks from RO & MM Allin & Son, Beaford to £136.

284ppk topped the market with 38.7kg Texels from RJ & MS Radford, Mariansleigh. Also from RJ & MS Radford were 35kg Suffolks to 283ppk. 44kg Texels from Beer Bros, Warkleigh to 282ppk. AJ Bragg & EM Jennings of Great Rapscott achieved 279ppk with their 40.8kg Suffolks. 2 pens at 278ppk, firstly from IFJ & JC Harris, Beaworthy for 45kg Texels. Then for 43.5kg Charollais from MJ King & Sons, Iddesleigh. 4 pens to 273ppk, firstly for 42.3kg Texels from PJ & BJ Millman, Chulmleigh; 44kg Charollais from WJ & MA Stoneman, Chulmleigh; 40kg Suffolks from PA Stentiford, Whiddon and 45.4kg Suffolks from IFJ & JC Harris.

549 CULL EWES & RAMS

Another excellent number entry again this week with the calf shed full up of ewes to get them all in. Overall quality would be less than last week with fewer bigger ewes on offer. Trade though continues to get dearer with ewes again another £5 per head dearer. The bigger leaner ewes are the most wanted but some of the smaller ewes around to £100-£110 mark look the dearest sold on the day. A new buyer in town helped the trade remain very strong from start to finish. Difficult to say how the trade will be next week with the festival ending this weekend. Best Suffolk Mules this week all £150 plus and but Mules this week all £130 plus. An impressive Suffolk from RH Dymond & Son, Croyde received a whopping £201, topping the overall market. A cracking Texel ewe from G Nicholls, Parracombe received a premium £200. Other notable prices were £193 for a Texel from A Richards, Kentisbury, £190 3 times, firstly a Texel from HJ & RH Mildon, Brayford; a Texel from DW Ridd, West Buckland and a Charollais from AW Price, Torrington. A well meated Texel from AS, EJ & RL Ash, North Tawton met with £184. 3 Texels from D Fergie, Ash Mill received £177. Texels again from AS, EJ & RL Ash achieved £172, and a pen of 6 Charollais from MA Milton, Chapelton met with £170. Closely following was 17 Suffolks from G Mills & Partners Ltd at £169.50.

Cull Rams topped at £187 for a Texel from MAF Roberts & AL Phillips, Dulverton. A Suffolk ram from Mr B Nicholls, Barnstaple realised £179 with a Cheviot from the same home at £170.

A pair of Goats forward today topped at £162 from Mr NA & Mrs VP Dykes of High Bickington.
