1254 PRIME LAMBS, 394 PRIME HOGGS & 405 CULL EWES & RAMS

1254 PRIME LAMBS

An increased entry this week and yet another super show of fresh sappy lambs on offer. Trade slightly easier than last week, which was expected for the lighter lambs (under 43kgs). However trade for the heavier lambs was dearer which is because there aren't as many coming forward and also as the hogg numbers begin to drop. Best trade for the well fleshed 44-47kg lambs which all buyers were after. It is again difficult to predict next weeks trade but at least the hogg numbers are beginning to drop which should help the lamb trade in the coming weeks. **Top today at £152.50 to 51kg Texel crosses from Messrs Sing & Avery of Mariansleigh** with £149 to 51kg Charollais crosses from Mr WJ Woollacott & Sons of Bishops Nympton. 51.7kg Charollais crosses from Mr DJ Woollacott of South Molton hit £148.50 along with a smart pen 45.2kg Texel crosses from Mr MJ King & Sons of Iddesleigh. £147.80 was achieved for 47.3kg Charollais crosses from Messrs B & T Baker of Alverdiscott with £146.80 to 49.4kg Charollais crosses again from Mr WJ Woollacott & Sons. 47kg Texel crosses from Mr B Beel of High Bickington realised £144.50 with £143.80 twice; the first to 45kg Texel crosses from Messrs T & L Cole of Heasley Mill and the second to 48.7kg Suffolk crosses from Mr DEJ Nott of Kennerleigh. Two pens of 47kg and 50.5kg Charollais crosses again from the Woollacott Family hit £143.50 closely followed at £143 for other similar pens.

Best pens today to 330ppk to fresh 39.4kg Texel crosses from Mr P Coles of Clayhanger with 329ppk to 45.2kg Texel crosses from Mr MJ King & Sons of Iddesleigh. Two pens to 322ppk; the first to 38.5kg Texel crosses from Mr MH Gillbard of Puddington and the second to 40kg Charollais crosses from Messrs Lucas & Ridge of Chulmleigh. 320ppk hit of four occasions; the first and second pens to 41.6kg and 42kg Charollais crosses from Mr G Mills & Partners Ltd of Witheridge; the third to 40kg Texel crosses from Mr CJ Campbell of Woolacombe and the fourth to 45kg Texel crosses from Messrs T & L Cole of Heasley Mill. 319ppk to 41.6kg Suffolk crosses from the Mills Family again who also had 42kg Texel and 41.4kg Suffolk cross pens at 318ppk. Four other pens reached 318ppk; the first to 42.1kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs FG & FM Saunders of Templeton; the second to 44kg Texel crosses from Warwick Farm Partnership of Moretonhampstead with the third and fourth pens to two 40.2kg Texel cross pens from Messrs Sing & Avery of Mariansleigh.

394 PRIME HOGGS

Fewer hogs forward this week as expected and a very mixed entry from start to finish. Trade all over the place with the best heavy hogs dearer, the well fleshed medium (44-47kg) hogs similar money and the lighter sorts a lot less money. The leaner, poorer hogs at this time of year were a lot less again.

Again there is a larger proportion of scaled hogs coming through each week but if they are well fleshed enough they are still only trading £10-15 behind the clean. **Best today at £163.50 to the final consignment of hogs from Mr MTD Pile of Dunkeswell being a super pen of 58.5kg Texel crosses** with other pens from the same farm to 59kg Suffolks at £163; 57kg Charollais at £160 and 56kg Suffolks at £157. £156.50 to 58kg Charollais crosses from Messrs H & M Thorne of Warkleigh closely followed at £156 to other 55kg Texel crosses from the Pile Family. £155.50 to 62.6kg Charollais crosses from Mr CR Mildon of Bishops Nympton; 53kg Texels again from Mr MTD Pile at £154 and £153 to 56kg Charollais crosses from Mr WJ Woollacott & Sons of Bishops Nympton.

A double top in the hogs with best pens to 297ppk to 46kg Texel crosses from Mr MTD Pile of Dunkeswell who sold further pens to 295, 293, 291,285,284,282,281, 280 and 279ppk respectively. 293ppk to 47kg Texel crosses from Messrs P & S Llewellyn of Oakford with 280ppk to 47.3kg Charollais crosses from Mr WJ Woollacott & Sons of Bishops Nympton and 48kg Texel crosses from Mr G Dart & Sons of Molland at 279ppk.

405 CULL EWES & RAMS

Another decent number of cull sheep this week however with fewer bigger ewes forward. Trade was again very similar to last week with no let up in the trade at all. All buyers present and all keen to secure ewes. All classes were wanted, even the overfat and very lean types. It has been reported this week that the ewes were going to drop due to poorer sales, but this now seems unlikely with another festival on the horizon. Best Suffolk Mules this week all £150 plus and all Mules this week £130 plus. **Top today at £177 to smart Texels from Mr KA Hill of Bideford** whose second similar pen followed at £174. Strong Zwartbles to £166 from Messrs Ravenhill-White of Chittlehampton with £164 to Pure Texels from Mr G Dart & Sons of Molland. Best Suffolk Mules to £162 from Messrs A & S Hoskin of Bishops Nympton with similar sorts from Mr KA Hill following at £161. Other blackfaces from Messrs T & L Cole of Heasley Mill at £160 and £153.50 from Messrs J & J Watts of Goodleigh. Two pens at £153; the first to whitefaces from Mr MD Parkin of Ilfracombe and the second to Suffolks from Mr WJ Woollacott & Sons of Bishops Nympton. Blackfaces from Mr MD Parkin again at £152.50 with other similar pens from Mr KA Hill at £150.50 and Mr WI Thorne & Son of Ashreigney at £150. Cheviot crosses from Messrs T & L Cole to £149.50 with four pens hitting £149; the first to Suffolk Mules from Mr CR Mildon of Bishops Nympton; the second to a Pure Texel from Mr R Butt of North Molton and the third and fourth pens to Suffolk Mules and Texel crosses both from Mr G Mills & Partners Ltd of Witheridge. **Just a handful of rams today with the best to Texels from Mr M Bristow of Witheridge at £145** who also sold a Charollais at £129
