

Auctioneer's comment:

Another great trade at Knighton proving there is no need to travel your store cattle when you have a great trade on your doorstep.

A entry of 25 Young Feeding Bulls sold well with 5 purchasers bidding up, to average 252.93ppk and £149.80 per head selling to 348ppk 2 Char X Bulls (10m) to £1305 from TW Jones & Son. Top price per head was £1640 for a Lim X Bull from (650KG) AAT Pugh. Also to £1410 for 2 Char X Bulls (510KG) from IL & AJ Powell & Sons.
Keep up the good entry of Bulls.

Steers averaged 248.44ppk and £127 per head selling to 334.3ppk for a 350kg BB X Steer (12m) from Probert & Probert. Top price per head was £1640 for a Lim X Steer (600kg) from JC Mills. Also to £1470 for 2 Lim X Steers (13m) 570kg from Probert & Probert. On the whole the heavier cattle would be the best trade but there was still good demand for grazing sorts.

Heifers averaged 245.96ppk and £1021.67 per head selling to 328.60ppk for a 315kg Char X Heifer (12m) from JP Breeze & Son. Also to 310.80ppk for a 370kg Lim X Heifer (12m) to £1150 from A Rowlands & Son. Top price per head was £1460 for a 11m Char X Heifer from IL & AJ Powell.

The 33 Cows & Calves averaged £2243 per outfit selling to £3000 for Highfield Master Lesley (2015) and her Limousin Bull Calf (2m). Also to £2850 for a Purebred Cow & Bull Calf (2m). ENGLAND - COUNTRYSIDE STEWARDSHIP SCHEME

Mid-Tier open until end of July 2022.

Capital Grants (inc: water, hedgerows & boundary items) now open.

DEFRA has announced an increase in payments rates for many Mid-Tier options.

For example, payments for GS5 Permanent grassland with very low inputs in SDAs increased from £16 to £71; GS2 Permanent grassland with very low inputs (outside SDAs) from £95 to £132; GS4 Legume and herb-rich swards from £309 to £358; HS1 Maintenance of Weatherproof Traditional Farm Buildings from £3.25 to £4.03 and SW1 4-6m buffer strip on cultivated land from £353 to £419.

These increases are relevant not only to the forthcoming 2023 agreements but to existing agreements with effect from 1st January 2022. A list of the revised payment rates can be found on Gov.UK. For those who have not yet engaged with Countryside Stewardship, especially Mid-Tier, we urge you to re-consider.

SMALL GRANTS - ENVIRONMENT (WATER) NOW OPEN!

The Small Grants - Environment (Water) is a standalone scheme providing a maximum of £7,500 funding per window for Capital Works Projects. Items include:

- New Hedge Planting
- Hedge Laying
- Rainwater Goods (Guttering & Downpipe)
- Maintenance of Gateways (Hardcore)
- Cross Drains

In addition, supportive capital works are also provided, such as Post & Wire Fencing with Stock Netting and Water Troughs.

The application period is open until 1st July 2022.

SMALL GRANTS EFFICIENCY SCHEME NOW OPEN

40% grant funding is available for farmers in Wales towards a range of farming equipment including:

- Livestock Handling Facilities including Weighing Systems and Cattle Crushes.
- Calving detectors
- 10t Feed Bins
- Camera for monitoring livestock
- Hay & Straw Moisture Meters
- Electric Fencing
- Diesel Tanks
- Bore holes and much more....

The grant minimum is £1,000 per application, therefore farmers must be applying for at least £2,500 worth of equipment, up to a maximum grant value of £12,000 (£30,000 worth of equipment).
