SUSTAINABLE FARMING INCENTIVE (SFI)

Now Open (England)

From 30th June, DEFRA invites applications for the first of three new Environmental Land Management (ELM) schemes being introduced under the Agricultural Transition Plan, which is primarily focused on soils.

It is available to current Basic Payment and Stewardship applicants, as long as no 'double funding' is occurring.

Up to 2025 the SFI will be developed to include more standards, however, the initial offerings are as follows:

- o Two soil standards Introductory and Intermediate levels
- o Arable & Horticultural Land £22/ha (Introductory) and £40/ha (Intermediate)
 - o Improved Grassland £28/ha (Introductory) and £58/ha (Intermediate)
 - o Moorland £10.30/ha (Introductory) plus additional £265 per agreement.

Agreements are for a three-year term and payments are to be made on a quarterly basis. There is no time window or deadline for applications. On-line applications only.

LUMP SUM EXIT SCHEME NOW OPEN

The Lump Sum Exit Scheme opened on 12th April and will remain open until 30th September 2022. It is available to farmers in England who wish to retire or leave the farming industry. It is based on the average direct payment made during 2019 to 2021 Basic Payment Scheme years, multiplied by 2.35 to calculate the lump sum payment, which is capped at £99,850. All entitlements will need to be surrendered and all land but 5ha will have to be sold, gifted or rented for a minimum of 5 years.

COUNTRYSIDE STEWARDSHIP CAPITAL GRANTS

- Open All Year Round

Standalone Capital Grants are now open all year round (subject to funding) for:

- · Boundaries, Trees and Orchards such as hedgerow coppicing, laying, stone wall restoration, wooden field gates, planting hedgerow trees and coppicing bankside trees.
 - Water Quality such as fencing, livestock troughs, hardcore tracks, concrete yard renewal, roofing over muck/silage stores and livestock handling areas, guttering and sprayer washdown areas.
 - Air Quality such as automatic slurry scraper and low emission flooring for livestock buildings.

The maximum grant available for any application is £60,000. However, there is a limit of £20,000 within group. Catchment Sensitive Farming Officer (CFSO) Approval is required for some items within the groups. If it becomes oversubscribed, a 6 weeks' notice will be given prior to closure.

SLURRY INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT

- Open Autumn 2022

DEFRA have announced that the Slurry Infrastructure Grant will be available from Autumn this year. It will be available to help replace, erect new or improve existing slurry storage facilities, in order to meet regulations to be capable of storage for at least 6 months. Funding is targeted at livestock farmers already using a slurry system. All grant funded stores will require an impermeable cover, unless slurry is treated as per requirements.

The grant is 50% funded, with the minimum grant available is £25,000, with the maximum being £250,000, and will provided against a range of slurry store types, impermeable covers, and additional apparatus such as pumps, pipes and safety equipment.

Additional information will be released later in the year. Applications are via two stage approach, with Stage 1, an eligibility checker being opened in Autumn and if successful you will be invited to apply in Stage 2 during the Winter.

THE FARMING INVESTMENT FUND (FIF)

- Adding Value - Now Open Until 21st July **ENGLAND ONLY**
The Third Round of the FIF is now open. Up to £30M is available to support farmers and growers to diversify and process their raw products in order to add value.

Grants will be available from £25,000 to £300,000 to help fund 40% of cost of eligible projects. Available to growers, producers and processors of agricultural and horticultural products.

The grant will be available for buildings, machinery or equipment to add value to eligible agricultural products after they have been harvested or reared, such as arable or horticultural crops, livestock products and non-food crops.

Applications are via two stage approach, with Stage 1, an eligibility checker is open until 21st July. If successful you will be invited to apply in Stage 2, where planning consent (if applicable) will be required as part of the application.
