152 SUCKLED CALVES

A decent trade for the annual show and sale of Suckled Calves. There was a smaller entry this year with a number of cattle being kept through the Winter to benefit from the Spring trade. Trade was very similar to recent months with the better bred and stronger cattle meeting good demand but the smaller suckled calves still proving difficult to sell.

Top price was £890 for a 7mo Charolais x steer from Messrs Westcott Farms, Brentor; which also won the Cornwall Farmer's Cup and a voucher kindly sponsored by Wynnstay.

Top price heifer also went to Westcott Farms, Brentor for a 7mo Charolais x which made £750; and won the Sully & Co Cup and a voucher kindly sponsored by Wynnstay.

The Westmoor Veterinary Centre Cup this year was won by Messrs C D, D M & S K Alford, South Zeal with his bunch of 3 8mo South Devon steers which realised £820 this was for the top priced purebred suckled calves and also won a voucher kindly sponsored by Bridgmans.

Roger Cole Farm & Shearing Supplies kindly sponsored the top priced two or more steers and heifers. The steers was won by Messrs F G & D M Penwill, Mary Tavy with their 2 7mo Simmental Steers realising £835. The heifers was won by Messrs J & G Nankivell, Tavistock with their 2 7mo Charolais x heifers realising £705. Other notable prices included £850 for a 8mo Limmousin x steer from Westcott Farms, Brentor; £810 for 2 8mo Charolais x steers from Messrs J & G Nankivell, Tavistock; £775 for 2 8mo Charolais x steers from Mr M H Northmore, Horrbridge; £800 for 2 6mo Simmental steers from Messrs F G & D M Penwill, Mary Tavy; £600 for 4 6mo South Devon steers from Mr G Watson, Postbridge; £700 for 8mo Charolais x heifers from Messrs J & G Nankivell, Tavistock; £545 for a bunch of 6 6mo Maine Anjou x steers from Messrs W A Cole & Sons, Sampford Spiney; and £600 for 3 8mo South Devon x steers from Mr A Bellamy, Peter Tavy.

The uncertain future of Environmental Land Management Schemes

Jack Dafters BA, Stags Graduate Rural Surveyor, discusses the circulation of rumours regarding the future of DEFRA's Environmental Land Management Schemes (ELMS), which has continued to cause uncertainty amongst farmers and land managers over the past few months.

ELMS are the first example of post-Brexit agri-environment schemes and are designed to replace the often-criticised, EU-funded Common Agricultural Policy (CAP), which provided payment based on area of land farmed.

ELMS are composed of the Sustainable Farming Incentive (SFI), Local Nature Recovery scheme and Landscape Recovery scheme. These new schemes are presented as a subsidy system in which farmers and landowners will be paid 'public money for public goods.' This will be based on providing environmental benefits such as soil health improvement or biodiversity increase at a variety of scales.

Media reports in recent weeks have suggested that a 'review' of ELMS may signal a possible U-turn with regards to their implementation. This has caused further anxiety and uncertainty for farmers who have already been voicing their disappointment concerning lack of clarity and disappointing payment rates in relation to the SFI.

DEFRA have claimed that there are no plans to scrap ELMS and a review will be released at the end of October 2022. However, they state that, "in light of the pressures farmers are facing as a result of the current global economic situation...it's only right that we look at how best to deliver the schemes to see where and how improvements can be made."

Clarity around grant payments is essential to many farmers and hopefully a clearer direction will emerge following the release of the October review.
