1287 PRIME HOGGS

the new year. Overall a decent quality entry with heavier hoggs on offer this week. Trade as expected easier this week with prices nationally easing at the very start of the week. Prices back generally £3-4 per head on last week for the 40-48kg hoggs; but trade for the 50kg plus hoggs actually very similar to last week with some weights actually dearer. All buyers in attendance but all looking to buy their sheep for less money with processers reporting a drop-in sale. If hogg numbers continue to come forward trade is likely to remain steady for the rest of the month Top price of £167.50 for three heavy 73.6kg Suffolk crosses for Parsonage Farms, Chumleigh. Followed be Messrs DW & J, Jones who had three pens in the top fifteen pens their first two pens were Texel crosses £151.50 for 62.5kg and £138.00 for 56.2kg and a pen of Suffolk crosses £144.00 for 58.4kg. Mr R J Shapland from Stoke Rivers had a Texel cross hogg £151.00 for 66.2kg. J T Agricultural Services LTD also had a Texel cross hogg £148.00 for 61kg. Mrs M Tapp from South Molton saw his pen of Charollais cross hoggs sell at £143.00 for 59.5kg, followed by Messrs DJ Cole and Sons of Brandnich who had two Charollais cross hoggs reach £141.50 for 57.5kg. Messrs G W Jones and Sons of South Molton had a Texel cross hogg at £140.00 for 59kg. Two pens reached £136.50 firstly a Charollais cross hogg for Messrs A & S Hoskin of Bishop Nympton for 56kg and secondly a pen of Suffolk crosses from Mr B.E.J Hallet from Pennymoor for 58.5kg. Mr J Bryant made the trip from Martinhoe with his Texel cross hogg £135.50 for 58kg. Top call of 247ppk for a pen of 21 Suffolk cross hogs weighing 58.4kg for Messrs DW & J Jones from Heasley Mill who also had three large pens of Texel cross hoggs at 246ppk at 56.2kg and 50.3kg and

245ppk at 49.7kg. Messrs D J Cole and Sons from Another decent number entry this week to start Bradninch had their Charollais crosses hoggs come in at 246ppk at 57.5kg. Messrs W E & O Petherick from Petrockstowe had a pen of Suffolk crosses 254ppk at 46kg. 244ppk was met twice firstly by a Charollais cross from Messrs A & S Hoskin from Bishop Nympton at 56kg and secondly by Messrs TH & PM Bolt from Huntsham at 46.2kg.

443 CULL EWES & 7 CULL RAMS

Again, a decent number entry to start the year and some good runs of ewes forward. Trade began very similar to the past three weeks and maybe a fraction dearer for the bigger meaty ewes. The very lean poorer ewes are less money and some of the grazing ewes are. Slightly easier trade with less buyers for them due to the wet weather and high feed costs. Best trade for the big meaty ewes as long as they're not over fat. Trade likely to remain similar for the coming weeks. Best Suffolk mules this week £115 plus and best mules this week £100 plus. Top Price £139 for a strong Suffolk cross ewe from Messrs R.H Dymond and Sons from Croyde. Messrs D J Govier and Partners from Chumleigh had a nice shaped Texel cross ewe at £138.00 Mr RJ Shapland from Stoke Rivers had a Suffolk cross ewe which came in at £129. Messrs a & S Hoskins from Bishops Nympton saw their Charollais ewe reach £126. Messrs AJ & MJ Tarr from West Anstey had two pens of Suffolk crosses which made £125.50 and £112 also a pen of Texel crosses at £125. Messrs R W Tapp and Sons from South Molton had a Suffolk cross at £119. Messrs J E and M Mather and Sons from Arlington had a pen of Texel crosses at £118. The top priced Ram was a large framed Texel from Messrs M J Hopper and Sons from South Molton followed by another Texel from good supporter Mr R Vigars who made the long trip from Minehead.
