was expected following yesterdays breeding sale and the continued better weather. Overall another good quality entry with a few more heavier lambs forward this week. Trade has started steadier this week with a number of abattoirs dropping the deadweight prices. Trade was actually better than predicted on the weekly market text and very similar to last week. The handy weight and heavy lambs were again wanted as long as they had good cover; and the lighter lambs although harder to sell were definitely dearer than last week with a few new faces looking to buy store lambs. Hopefully the trade has bottomed and we will see some improvement in the coming weeks but numbers being sold nationally in the last two week have been lower. Best pens today rose to 280ppk to 55kg Charollais crosses from Mr R Irwin of Kings **Nympton** whose second pen of 52.7kg Lleyns followed at 275ppk. 273ppk to 51kg Charollais crosses from Messrs IP & L Stagg of Newton Tracey with 272ppk again to 57kg Charollais crosses from Mr R Irwin. 271ppk to 52kg Charollais crosses from Messrs A & S Hoskin of Bishop Nympton with 270ppk twice; the first to 51.8kg Charollais crosses from Mr W Milton of Chapelton and the second to 50kg Texel crosses from Mr N Rottenbury of Heasley Mill. 52.4kg Suffolk crosses from Mr RH Dymond & Son of Croyde hit 267ppk with 266ppk to 56.3kg Charollais crosses again from Messrs Stagg. 265ppk hit four times; the first to 49.5kg Charollais crosses from Mr G Mills & Partners Ltd of Witheridge; the second to 55kg Texel crosses from Mr AE Chudley & Son of Romansleigh: the third to 60kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs A & S Hoskin again and the third to Messrs Stagg's third pen of 52.5kg Charollais crosses.

other 55kg pens. £150 hit four times; the first to A smaller entry of prime lambs this week which 56.3kg Charollais crosses from Messrs IP & L Stagg of Newton Tracey; the second to 60kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs AD & SM Bray of Knowstone; the third to 57.1kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs G & P Kivell of Ashreigney and the fourth pen to 64kg Suffolk crosses from Mr G Mills & Partners Ltd of Witheridge. 59kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs Lucas & Ridge of Chulmleigh rose to £148.

264 CULL EWES & RAMS:

As with the lambs a smaller entry of cull sheep this week and a lot of local farmers of standstill. Again a very mixed entry with a large proportion of plain and lean ewes forward this week. Trade actually a touch dearer than last week even though the overall average was back (which was due to more small, plain ewes on offer). More buyers beginning to look for the grazing ewes and overall trade likely to remain strong in the coming weeks. Best Suffolk Mules this week £116 plus (very few) and best Mules £105. Top of the day at £132 to an Aberblack ram from Mr R Crang of Dulverton who sold others to £131. Best ewes to £124.50 to Suffolk Mules from Mr MD Bray of Knowstone with other blackfaces from Messrs A & S Hoskin of Bishops Nympton at £119. Texel crosses from Mr G Mills & Partners Ltd of Witheridge to £118 with Suffolk Mules from Mr W Moore & Sons of Rackenford at £117. Closely following at £116.50 to other similar blackfaces from Mr JF Norman of Shirwell, Closewools from Messrs S & J Bale of Challacombe at £116 with Bluefaced Leicesters from Messrs Lucas & Ridge of Chulmleigh at £114.50, the same money as Suffolk Mules again from the Mills family. Other Suffolk Mules from Mr B Elston of Rose Ash hit £109.50.

SHEARLING EWES:

An excellent entry of over 2800 sheep forward for the annual and full mouths to £120. sheep fair sale. Trade was strong throughout the day with the quality, stronger sheep the most wanted. In the breeding ewe OLDER EWES: section trade topped at £200 twice in the Suffolk Mule The sale started off with an super entry of genuine farming Molton. Overall the Suffolk Mule shearlings averaged £171.61.

and £180. Next best was £195 for a pen of 20 from Mr W as other similar mules from Messrs A & C Rowland of Bampton. Smale of North Molton who also sold further pens to £190 and £182. Messrs DWC & MJ Elworthy of Satterleigh had two pens **EWE LAMBS**: of 20 both realise £185. Other notable prices included £178 A small show of ewe lambs peaked at £128 to Texel Mules (x2) from Messrs GR & LTD McLeod of Swimbridge and Mr LAJ from Mr AJ Dart of Chulmleigh with Suffolk Mules from Mr ME England of Tiverton. £175 (x2) both from Mr SJ Dallyn of Snell & Son of Knowstone at £120 twice. Barnstaple with the overall mule average hitting £177.09.

Whiteface shearlings saw the best to £192 for a pen of Texel Mules from Messrs H & M Thorne & Sons of Warkleigh who also sold others to £182. Next best at £188 for another pen of Texel Mules from Messrs RJ & JC Rottenbury of Black Dog whose second pen followed closely at £185. Other notable prices included £182 for Texel Mules from Mr ME Snell & Son of Knowstone; £170 to further Texel Mules from Mrs M Tapp of South Molton. £165 (x2) to Exmoor Mules from Messrs DWC & MJ Elworthy of Satterleigh and £160 to Blue Faced Leicester cross Texels from Mr MEJ Branfield & Sons of Wiveliscombe. Overall the whiteface shearlings average £140.53.

FLOCK DISPERSALS:

This years fair included three flock dispersals which all met £200 and £170. much interest. First into the ring was 160 homebred, mainly purebred Lleyns from Tim Buddon of Higher Hacknell Farms Partnership. He topped at £160 for 4T ewes with full mouths to £158; shearlings to £155 and 6T to £155. Mrs M Tapp of South Molton and family have been great supporters of South Molton market over many years and today was the day they dispersed the flock of mainly Suffolk and Texel Mules. Prices topped at £185 for their Suffolk Mules shearlings with the 4T Suffolks following at £180; 6T Suffolk Mules to £160 and full mouths to £140. The Texel Mules sold to £170 for the shearlings; 4T to £162 and 6T to £155. Messrs Fuller & Son of Chulmleigh was the third and final dispersal of the day with just over 400 mainly purebred Lleyn ewes forward. Pens for the family peaked to

£140 for 4T with the shearlings followed at £135. 6T to £115

shearlings; firstly to a pen of 24 from Mr RW Tapp & Son of aged ewes which met a buoyant trade throughout with a 100% South Molton and the secondly to a pen of 15 from Messrs RJ clearance. Topping at £188 twice; both to 4T Suffolk Mules & JC Rottenbury of Black Dog. Mr RW Tapp & Son had a from Messrs BW, MR & SW Cottle of Petrockstowe and the wonderful run of Suffolk Mule shearlings and had other pens to second to Messrs IFJ & JC Harris of Beaworthy with other pens £195 (x2); £188; £185 (x3). Other Suffolk Mule shearlings hit to £160 for 4T from the Cottle family and £158 and for the £188 for a pen of 21 from Messrs H & M Thorne & Sons of Harris family. 4T North Country Mules from Messrs H & M Warkleigh and £185 for a pen from Mrs M Tapp of South Thorne & Sons of Warkleigh topped at £162 with full mouth Suffolk Mules again from Messrs Harris peaked at £148. Messrs GR & LTD McLeod sold their run of 2 crop North Country Mules A decent entry of over 600 North Country Mule shearlings to a top of £140 three times with others to £135. Full mouth topped at £198 for a pen of 22 from Messrs H & M Thorne & North Country Mules from Mr FC Reed of North Molton rose to Sons of Warkleigh who also sold other pens to £185 (x2); £182 £128 with their second pen following at £120, the same money

RAMS:

Rams saw a reduced entry this year with a selective trade from start to finish. Quality bred rams in demand however the smaller sorts difficult to place. Top today at £670 to a shearling Suffolk from Messrs RJ & SJ Geake of Tavistock with Charollais shearlings from annual consignor Mr D Smith of Chulmleigh at £550 three times and £520 respectively. Other Charollais shearlings to £550 from Mr GA Endacott & Son of Spreyton who sold other similar shearlings to £500 twice. A slim show of Texel shearlings this year saw the best to £480 from Mrs CA Smale of North Molton. Older rams today saw the best to full mouth Texels from Mrs M Tapp of South Molton topped at £220 twice. 6T Lleyns from the Higher Hacknell Farms realised
