Just thank you for every vendor for again choosing talybont for the sale of your lambs. Tuesday's entry of lambs were a yard which would be as good as you will find anywhere. A good entry of show lambs which was judged by Paul Hughes, Gower Coast Meats. He awarded 1st and Champion to the Joseph family, Lloyney with a pen of 45kg Beltex x ewe lambs later selling for £235. He awarded reserve champion to the winner of the hill class which was Rob Davies Prygad later selling for £117 weighing 46kg. The winner of the Bwlch and Crickhowell Yfc class was Becky Rees with 48kg texel x lambs coming down at £129. A great entry of show lambs and thanks must be given to those who entered.

Moving on the commercial lambs a fast trade from start to finish with 5 buyers shouting up in front of you to bid for them!! Any type was wanted with the lowland bred medium weights selling at 260-277p/kg. Hill bred tups 250-260p/kg. Topping this was J Watkins with 39kg at £107.20. Heavy lambs with the reports at the end of the week that they were harder sold, that certainly wasn't the case with us heavier the better. Again well bred lambs and plenty of them on offer and were trading between 255-270p/kg. Cheviot tup lambs trading anywhere from 245-257p/kg. A much stronger entry of super heavy weights with 102 on offer and were easily sold again between 130-£150 and was easily achieved. Smalls again still no massive jump on these certainly not on hill bred lambs. Better bred sorts easily sold at 250-270p/kg with a pen of 36kg selling at £94.20. Hill bred tups trading either side of 240p/kg. On the whole another full yard of quality lambs.
