An improved entry this week, with a lot more hill bred hogs on offer but they were very well covered in fact the whole were a credit to our vendors for turning out well meated hogs. I asked for leaner light hogs and they came not in big numbers but enough for everyone. Those light hogs mainly traded around 250-265p/kg with the better bred sorts 270-284p/kg. Topping the lights were a pen of 37kg at £104.20 which averaged 284p/kg from JAM Davies Panthowell. The medium weights again were a solid trade with plenty of hogs trading at 280+p/kg for better bred hogs, hill hogs 260-270p/kg. Topping at 292p/kg was G & D Owens. Cilgwyn for 40kg at £116. Heavy hogs still a very decent trade again same story better sorts trading over 270p/kg. D M Andrews selling their first pen of the season at 285p/kg for 48kg. Less heavy hogs on offer this week, and mainly cheviot tup hogs. M R Williams back in the top price report with 56kg Cheviot tup hogs coming down at 259p/kg. On the whole a pleasing day's trading with hopefully a sign to come that the Hogg trade is hear to stay. Bearing in mind this time last year our SQQ was 228.92p/kg.
