Well no one ever thought we would see hoggets being sold at £200. It happened today a trade which was dearer than reported yesterday. A smaller entry this week which was expected due to our recent numbers but again a very strong trade throughout. Plenty of business being done over £150. The top 10 pens all being sold over £160 with top PPH from Bill Edwards at £200 for 5 hogs at 69kg his next pen also selling at £195.50 for 4 hogs at 65kg. The super heavy hoggs averaged £181.24. The smaller entry of heavy hoggs averaging 321.04p/kg with a top from DM Andrews for 46kg at 333p/kg (£153). Will Jones again showed an exceptional pen of export hoggs with his leading pen selling for 350p/kg for 37kg leaving his run of 120 averaging 40.5kg at 328p/kg. Hill bred medium weights trading at 310-320p/kg. The light section enjoyed a buoyant trade which was pleasing with the entry showing a lot more end of season hoggs. These trading from 310-340p/kg. Better bred sorts trading at 325-350p/kg. The lighter weight hoggs would be the biggest improvement on the week. On the whole a disappointing entry this week when many more could have easily been sold but smaller entries helping the trade around the country.
