SOUTH MOLTON LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

THURSDAY 4TH APRIL 2024

1604 SHEEP SOLD

1146 PRIME HOGGS, 50 NEW SEASON LAMBS & 408 CULL EWES, RAMS & GOATS

LAMBS (50)

A few more New Season Lambs on offer this week. Only a few very fresh sappy lambs which sold well but average back as quite a few older lambs forward this week. Buyers are continually asking for more lambs, and trade likely to remain 'red hot' going forward.

Top lamb sales this week to Mr T Buckingham of Cove for his 55kg Dorset lamb which achieved £220.50, another notable pen of Dorsets from the same vendor reached £193.50 for a pen of 44.8kg lambs. Mr R Lawrence of Iddesleigh saw the best of his Suffolk lambs to £217.00 for a 54kg lamb and further Suffolk lambs to £209.00 for a 52kg lamb and £187.00 for a 44kg lamb. Messrs M & ML Gillbard of East Worlington saw the best of their lambs to £191.50 for a pair of 47.5kg lambs.

448ppk was the top pence per kilo for the lambs which was seen by Messrs M & ML Gillbard of East Worlington for their pen of 39.6kg lambs. Mr T Buckingham of Cove achieved 432ppk for his pen of 44.8kg lambs. 425ppk was seen by Mr R Lawrence of Iddesleigh for his 44kg lamb.

PRIME HOGGS (1146)

A decent number entry this week and overall a very mixed quality entry. More heavy hogs forward this week as well as more lighter and leaner hogs forward. Trade again dearer on the week especially for the well finished hogs. Lots of pens over the £200 mark and we reached a new high of £260.00 this week. The heavy hogs were very wanted as were those well finished 43-47kgs hogs. The leaner hogs are probably a very similar trade as time is beginning to pass. We are finding a few more hogs with their teeth beginning to erupt and these are generally £20-£30 per head behind the clean teeth hogs. Also a number of hogs are coming in very dirty which would sell better if they had been bellied. Nationally numbers remain short and trade likely to continue strong in the coming month.

Topping the market this week was Messrs Bonners Farm of Burrington with their 81kg Suffolk hogg which achieved £260.00. Messrs IFJ & JC Harris of Sheepwash saw their 75kg hogg to £258.00. £254.00 was seen by Messrs MG & SR Kingdon of Swimbridge for their pair

66.5kg hogs. Mr S Stentiford of South Molton saw the best of his hogs to £250.00 for a 65kg hogg. £246.50 was achieved by Messrs Irwin & Sons of Mariansleigh for their pen of 66.6kg hogs, the same vendor also had a pen of 64kg hogs reach £240.50. Mrs PA Stentiford of Muddiford saw the best of her hogs to £243.00 for a 64kg hogg. £241.00 was seen by Mr M Stevens of Dunkswell for his pen of 65kg hogs. £235.00 was seen twice firstly for Messrs WJ Crocker & Sons of Merton for their pen of 65kg hogs and secondly for Messrs J & H Searle for their pen of hogs which were also 65kg.

Top pence per kilo of 419ppk was seen twice, firstly for Mr R Frankpitt of Chevithorne for his pen of 28 45.8kg Texel hogs, and secondly for Mornacott Conservation of Bishops Nympton for their pen of 24 44.2kg hogs, the same vendor also had another notable pen of 48.7kg hogs to 409ppk. Mr S Andrew of Shebbear saw a 49kg hogg to 411ppk and 409ppk was seen again this time for Messrs BW, MR & SW Cottle of Petrockstowe for their pen of 46.3kg hogs. This was closely followed by Messrs Irwin & Sons of Mariansleigh who saw the best of their hogs to 408ppk for a pen of 45kg hogs. 406ppk was seen twice firstly for Messrs J & H Searle of Ash Mill for their pair of 47.5kg hogs and secondly for Mr R Frankpitt of Chevithorne for his pen of 16 46.8kg hogs.

CULL EWES, RAMS & GOATS (406)

A good number of forward this week and as with hogs a very mixed entry. A lot of smaller and very lean ewes forward this week which just back the overall average. Trade no less with some of the bigger better ewes dearer again this week. All ewes are wanted and those plain ewes look the dearest sold. Ramadan is coming to an end shortly which appears to be fuelling demand but general consensus is trade likely to remain strong going forward. Best Suffolk Mules this week all over £150 mark and best Mules all over £130 mark.

Top ewe sale this week was £215.00 for Mr FC Reed of North Molton for his pen of Texel ewes. Mr R Irwin of Kings Nympton saw the best of his Suffolk ewes to £190.00 and then a pair of Suffolk's from the same vendor reached £179.50. £166.00 was seen for Mr DJ Gavier & Partners of Chulmleigh for their pen of Whitefaced ewes. £165.00 was seen twice firstly for Messrs DJ & RA Woollacott of Yarnscombe for their pair Suffolk ewes and secondly for Mr B Nicholls of Parracombe for his pair of Blue Faced Leicester ewes.

Top ram call this week was £170.00 which was seen twice, firstly for Mr S Stentiford of South Molton for his Texel Ram and secondly for Mr MF Bellew of Bideford for his Suffolk Ram, the same vendor also saw his Texel ram to £160.00. Messrs Mildon & Ley of Bishops Nympton saw their Charollais ram achieve £149.50.
