NEW SEASON LAMBS (798)

A very similar number forward to last week and overall a decent quality entry. Trade has eased nationally again this week and with the forthcoming bank holiday most lambs sold today will not be killed until next Tuesday. Trade easier with the best lambs around the 400ppk mark. Best trade again was those well fed well covered lambs. Overall a very level trade from start to finish with the lighter lambs harder to sell and very few heavy lambs on offer.

Top call today was £210.50 for Mr R Lawrence of Idedesleigh for his 63kg Suffolk lamb. £196.00 was seen for a 53kg lamb from Mr R.A.P Grant of Cruwys Morchard. £190.00 was seen twice both times For MR EJ Westaway of Newton Tracey Firstly for a pen of 51.3kg lambs, secondly for a pen of 49.3kg Lamb. Mr EJ Westaway also had 46.3kg lambs just behind this at £189.50. also at £189.50 was also seen for Messrs B & T Baker of Alverdiscott with their 46.3kg Charollais X lambs. £187.50 was seen twice firstly for Messrs RJ & AD Nicholls of West Anstey with their 49kg Lambs, Secondly for Messrs Parsongage Farms of Chulmleigh with their pen of 50.2kg Suffolk lambs. £187.00 was seen four times with three of these being from Mr MA Milton of Umberleigh with a 47kg lamb, a 50kg lamb and a pen of 47.3kg lambs. Messrs CJ & LM Hill were the other vendor at £187.00 with their 47kg Charollais X lamb.

Top ppk this week came from Messrs RO & MM Allin & Son of Beaford with their pen of 44.8kg lambs. Closely behind this at 409ppk was Messrs B & T Baker of Alverdiscott with their pen of 46.3kg lambs. 408ppk was seen for Messrs GF & PJ Warne of Umberleigh with their pen of 14 39.7kg lambs. 404ppk was seen twice firstly for Messrs JC & ME Barnes & Son of Braunton with their 42.8kg lambs, secondly for Messrs GN & C Harding of Holsworthy with their 41.5kg lambs. Just behind this at 403ppk was Mr CJ Campbell of Woolacombe with his pen of 20 39.7kg lambs. Messrs T L Dennis & Partners saw the best of there lambs to 401ppk for 43.4kg. Messrs G Mills & Partners in with another quality run this week topping out at 400ppk for 14 43.3kg lambs.

week with the bigger well covered hogs the most wanted.

Topping the hogs this week was Mr S Stentiford of South Molton with his 85kg Texel hogg. MATURE SHEEP (71)

Similar number forward to last week and trade also very similar to last week. The better covered hogs are the most wanted and the leaner scaled hogs are difficult to sell.

Top scaled hogg this week was £181.00 from Mrs M Ellis of Goodleigh with her pen of 61.2kg scaled hogs. Mr MTD Pile of Dunkeswell saw the best of his run of scaled hogs to £178.00 for a pen of 65.7kg Scaled Hogs.

CULL EWES & RAMS (252)

A smaller number entry this week and overall a better quality entry forward with some more bigger and well bred ewes on offer this week. Trade dearer with more buyers around the ring and all buyers wanting ewes. Overall most ewes would be up at least £10 per head on last week. All ewes were well wanted especially those well covered and 3/4 meat ewes. The smaller and leaner ewes were also much dearer and noticeably that a few new grazing ewe buyers were around the ring but could not buy any. Best Suffolk mules this week £165 plus and best Mules this week £140 plus.

Topping the market this week was Messrs MC & KD Yeo of Yarnscombe with their Texel X ewe achieving £246.00. Following this at £201.00 was Messrs G Dart and Sons of Molland with their Texel X ewe. £197.00 was seen for Messrs AE Chudley & Son of Romansleigh with their Texel X ewe. Top price Suffolk this week was £189.00 for a pen from Mr G Mills and Partners of Chulmleigh.

Topping the Rams this week was Messrs MC & KD Yeo of Yarnscombe with their Texel ram. Following this at £173.00 was Messrs MH & MA Gillbard of Puddington.
