1181 NEW SEASON LAMBS, 244 PRIME HOGGS, 88 MATURE SHEEP, 286 CULL EWES & RAMS

NEW SEASON LAMBS (1181)

A bigger entry this week with a very varied entry forward. A lot of lambs in the 41-43kgs weight range this week and very few lambs over 50kgs on offer. More buyers around the ring this week and trade very similar to last week. A very level trade from start to finish with the best lambs (44-46kgs) selling around the 400ppk and the overall average again around the 390ppk mark. Again some lovely runs of quality lambs on offer and also a number of those lighter leaner lambs forward which brought the overall average back. Many are predicting the trade to keep falling in the coming weeks as numbers coming forward appear plentiful nationally. This week we started picking the Ram Lambs for the Qurbani festival as requested by some of the buyers. It no doubt helped the trade and the Ram Lambs are likely to be more wanted in the coming weeks.

Topping the market this week was Miss P Westaway of Newton Tracey with her 58kg lamb that achieved £237.00. Mrs PA Stentiford of Muddiford achieved £234.00 for her 57kg lamb the same vendor had a further lamb weighing 53kg reach £205.50. £208.00 was seen for Messrs Tucker Crooke Burnell Ltd of North Tawton for their pen of 54kg lambs. Mr MJ Avery of Yarnscombe saw his 53kg lamb to £204.00.

Mrs PA Stentiford of Muddiford had the top ppk in the New Season Lamb sale with her 57kg lamb to 411ppk, this was followed by Messrs Bonners Farm of Burrington who saw their pen of 42.1kg lambs reach 410ppk. 409ppk was seen by Miss P Westaway of Newton Tracey for her 58kg lamb, this was closely followed by Messrs W & EA Tratt of Luppit saw their 48kg lamb to 408ppk. 402ppk was seen for Messrs Tucker Crooke Burnell Ltd of North Tawton for their pen of 44.2kg lambs.

PRIME HOGGS (244)

A few more hogs forward this week and a very varied quality entry on offer. Trade easier across the board with the leaner well finished hogs the most wanted, and the lean hogs very difficult to sell. The hogg season is drawing to a close and soon most abattoirs will have turned over to the lambs.

Top call in the Prime Hogg sale this week was Messrs WJ Crocker & Sons of Merton who saw their pair of 60kg

hogs to £206.00. Mr C Reid of Abbotsham saw £200.00 twice firstly for his pair of hogs weighing 69.5kg and secondly for single hogg weighing 65kg, the same vendor also had another notable pen of 56kg hogs to £189.00. Messrs MA & EJ Bennett Ltd of Broadhembury saw their pair of 56.5kg hogs to £183.50.

Top pence per kilo was 371ppk for Mr MTD Pile of Dunkeswell with his 46kg hogg. 343ppk was seen twice firstly for Messrs WJ Crocker & Sons of Merton for their pair 60kg hogs and secondly for Messrs A & C Rowland of Bampton for their pen of 46.6kg hogs. Messrs DEJ Nott of Kennerleigh saw their 50kg hogg achieve 340ppk.

MATURE SHEEP (88)

A bigger number entry again this week and as with the hogs trade eased across the board. Best trade for the well fleshed leaner scaled hogs and the lighter and lean scaled hogs difficult to sell.

Top scaled hogg price this week was £164.00 for Messrs Ravenhill-White of Chittlehampton for their 70kg scaled hogg. Mr MTD Pile of Dunkeswell saw £158.00 for his pen of 64.3kg Whitefaced scaled hogs, another notable pen from the same vendor saw a pen of 66kg Suffolk scaled hogs to £157.00. £157.00 was seen for a second time this time by Messrs Bonners Farm of Burrington for their 59kg Suffolk scaled hogg.

CULL EWES & RAMS (286)

A similar number entry this week and a similar trade overall. Not so many big ewes forward this week and a lot more leaner ewes forward this week. Trade probably slightly easier for the bigger best ewes and the very lean ewes but very similar for the 3/4 meat and well framed ewes. Trade likely to remain strong in the lead up to the Qurbani festival which is due to fall in the middle of June. Best Suffolk Mules this week £160 plus and best Mules this week £140 plus.

Messrs A & S Hoskin of Bishops Nympton topped the ewe sales this week with their ewe the achieved £193.00. Messrs D & S Partridge of South Molton saw their pair of ewes to £174.00. £171.50 was seen for Messrs FJ Sing & TGJ Avery of Mariansleigh for their pen of Suffolk ewes. Messrs CJ & LM Hill of Yarnscombe saw their Suffolk ewe to £169.00, this was closely followed by Messrs RR & J Symons of South Molton who saw their pen of ewes achieve £168.00.

Top ram price this week was £171.00 for Messrs MJ & DM Lake of South Molton for their ram, the same vendor had a further ram achieve £157.00. Mr R Coe of East Anstey saw his ram reach £160.00 and Messrs AE Chudley & Son of Romansleigh saw their ram to £150.00.
