PRIME LAMBS (1042)

A smaller number entry this week which was expected as the trade nationally has fallen again this week. Overall a decent quality entry forward with much fewer lighter and leaner lambs on offer this week. Trade actually not back as much as was expected with the trade getting slightly stronger as the sale went on. The lesser numbers and the better quality entry (more well fed heavier lambs) just kept the trade up near last week. The heavier lambs were a bit more wanted this week and the lambs most buyers were looking for were the 45-47kg well covered lambs. The lighter lambs were less per kilo but there are buyers around the ring looking for those 'feeding' lambs. Difficult to predict next weeks trade with many predicting deadweight prices will drop again next Monday.

Top call in the prime lamb market this week was Mr S Stentiford of South Molton with his pair of 56.5kg lambs which reached £174.00. Mr S D Charles of Rackenford saw his pen of 55.8kg lambs achieve £169.50. £165.00 was seen twice this week in the lamb sales, firstly for Messrs DJ & RA Woollacott of Yarnscombe for their pen of 55.5kg lambs and secondly for Mr G Mills & Partners Ltd of Witheridge with their 58kg Charollais lamb. This was closely followed by Mr JK May of Bideford with his pen of 53.3kg lambs to £164.00. Messrs W & EA Tratt of Luppitt saw their pen 53.3kg lambs to £163.50. £162.50 was achieved for Messrs G & P Kivell of Ashreigney with their pen of 53kg lambs and £160.00 was seen twice on both occasions for Messrs JM Becklake Ltd of Bishops Nympton firstly for a lamb weighing 53kg and secondly for a pair of 57kg lambs.

Top Pence Per Kilo in the lamb sales this week was seen by Messrs Tucker Crooke Burnell Ltd of North Tawton with their pen of 50kg lambs which achieved 320ppk, the same vendor had further notable pens to 319ppk for a pen of lambs weighing 49.5kg and for a pen of 19 lambs weighing 49.7kg. Mr R Irwin of Kings Nympton saw his pen of 47kg lambs to 312ppk, this was closely followed by 311ppk for Messrs DJ & RA Woolacott of Yarnscombe with their pen of 49.7kg lambs. 309ppk was seen by Mrs PA Stentiford of Muddiford for her pair of 49.5kg lambs. 308ppk was achieved twice this week firstly for Mr S Stentiford of South Molton for his pair of

56.5kg lambs and secondly for Mr JK May of Bideford for his pen of 53.3kg lambs.

HOGGS & MATURE SHEEP (15)

Last week this week selling these separately with only a short entry now.

Messrs AE Chudley & Son of Romansleigh saw their pair of 52kg hogs to £130.00, the same vendor had a further hogg weighing 47kg to £78.00.

Messrs JM Becklake Ltd of Bishops Nympton saw their pair of 59kg scaled hogs achieve £136.00, the same vendor had a further hogg weighing 74kg to £106.00. Messrs AE Chudley & Son of Romansleigh saw their pen of 59.7kg hogs to £117.00.

CULL EWES & RAMS (332)

A decent number entry this week although a few less than last week. Overall a good quality entry forward this week and again a large contingent of Mule ewes on offer. Trade very much as dear as last week with buyers very keen on mature ewes. All ewes with good covering were well wanted this week and sold to a very strong trade throughout. Again a few grazing ewe buyers around the ring this week but the ewes were too dear for them to buy. Unlikely ewes will get any dearer and may just begin to slip back in the coming weeks with the lamb trade having already dropped. Best Suffolk Mules this week £155 plus and best Mules this week £130 plus.

Topping the market this week was Messrs Eastman & Bolt of High Bickington with their Whitefaced ewe which achieved £175.00. Messrs DJ & RA Woollacott of Yarnscombe saw their pen of Suffolk ewes to £171.00, the same vendor had further pen of Suffolk ewes achieving £159.00 and a single Whitefaced ewe that also reached £159.00. Messrs Tucker Crooke Burnell of North Tawton saw their pen of Suffolk ewes to £165.00. £160.00 was seen twice firstly for Messrs TH & PM Bolt of Huntsham with their pen of ewes and secondly for Messrs RH Dymond & Son of Croyde with their pair of Suffolk ewes. £158.00 was seen three times this week firstly for Messrs Tucker Crooke Burnell with their Mule ewe. Secondly for Messrs DJ Govier & Partners of Chumleigh for their pair of Suffolk ewes and thirdly for Mr S Avery of Yarnscombe with his ewe. Messrs M Tester & S Edwards of East Anstey saw their ewe achieve £155.00.

£171.00 was the top price in the ram sales this week which was achieved by Messrs Tucker Crooke Burnell of North Tawton with their Charollais ram. Messrs DEJ Nott of Kennerleigh saw their ram to £130.00 and Messrs GF & PJ Warne of Umberleigh saw their Charollais ram achieve £100.

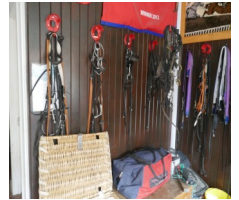

Sustainable Farming Incentive—Expanded offer for 2024



Sally Blowey MRICS FAAV, Associate & Rural Chartered Surveyor, discusses the changes to the Sustainable Farming Incentive for 2024 and how, with over 100 actions it may be worth looking at again for your farm; The RPA have released details of the expanded Sustainable Farming Incentive (SFI) offer for 2024, the scheme will be available to most farmers to apply for from 22nd July 2024. If you are interested in applying sooner you can submit an Expression of Interest and the RPA will invite people to apply as part of a controlled rollout so the process can be adjusted as required.

SFI pays farmers to take actions that can help improve farm productivity, make farms and food production more resilient, and improve the natural environment and climate. Agreements are for a term of 3 or 5 years, applications will be open year-round with agreements commencing on the first day of the calendar month following their acceptance. Under an SFI agreement, the annual payment is paid in quarterly instalments. The first payment is usually made in the fourth month after an agreement's start date.

For 2024, the number of actions on offer through SFI will increase from 23 to 102. With new actions for precision farming, moorland, flood and water management, agroforestry and no till and updated versions of actions previously available under the mid-tier scheme and the 2023 SFI offer.



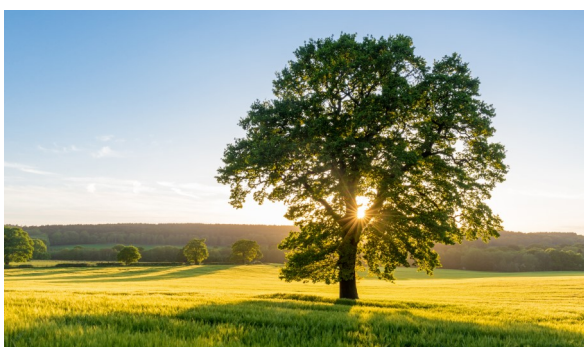
Some of the actions available under the 2024 SFI include;

- Maintain or establish hedgerow trees—£10 per 100 metres for both sides
- Maintain earth banks or stone-faced hedgebanks—£11 per 100 metres for one side
- Manage grassland with very low nutrient inputs—£151 per hectare
- Maintain weatherproof traditional farm or forestry buildings—£5 per square metre
- Assess soil, produce a soil management plan and test soil organic matter—£6 per hectare and an additional payment of £97 per agreement
- Multi-species winter cover crop- £129 per hectare
- Herbal leys £382 per hectare
- Remove livestock from grassland during the autumn and winter - £115 per hectare

In addition to the actions, the RPA will also pay an SFI management payment to cover the administrative costs of joining the scheme. The management payment will pay £40 per hectare for up to the first 50 hectares entered into an eligible agreement and £20/ha for the first 50 hectares for years 2 and 3.
