PRIME LAMBS (747)

A smaller number entry this week as the national trade continues to gradually come back. The smaller number entry probably helped keep the trade not too far behind last week. Overall the trade for the medium weight lambs would be back more markedly especially those 49-52kg lambs. It was generally a good quality entry although still a number of leaner and light lambs forward. As with previous weeks best trade for those lambs that are well covered whatever the weight with the leaner lambs discounted though there are finishing buyers still around the ring.

Topping the market this week was Messrs DJ & RA Woollacott of Yarnscombe for their pen of 63.2kg lambs achieving £189.00, the same vendor had further pens of 59.6kg and 57.8kg lambs to £175.00, 58.3kg lambs to £173.00 and 56.8kg lambs to £165.50. £184.00 was seen for Messrs IP & L Stagg of Newton Tracey for their pen of 63.7kg lambs, the same vendor had a further pen of 58.5kg lambs to £176.00. A good number of buyers around the ring including grazing ewe buyers. Trade usually weakens at this time of year, so not unexpected. Best Suffolk Mules this week £125 plus and best Mules this week £105 plus.

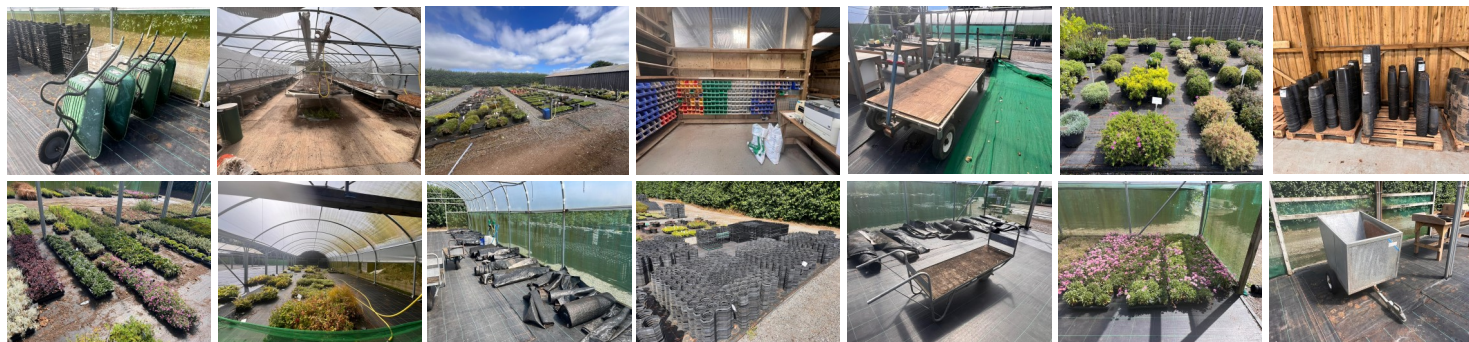
