19TH SEPTEMBER 2024

501 PRIME LAMBS & 111 CULL EWES & RAMS

PRIME LAMBS (501)

A very low number entry this week with numbers affected by the recent breeding sales in the area and the final days of the settled weather. Overall again a pretty mixed quality entry with a number of leaner lambs forward pulling the overall average lower than the 300ppk mark. Trade slightly dearer than last week which was no doubt helped by the smaller number entry. All well finished lambs were well wanted and sold in excess of 300ppk. Best trade for those strong meat lambs especially the heavier (over 52kg) which were fewer in number this week. Trade has been very variable throughout the country this week and a number of abattoirs have dropped their prices this week.

Topping the market this week was Messrs DMJ & CM Kingdom of Bishops Nympton with their pen of 61kg lambs achieving £183.50.

£183.00 was seen for Messrs DJ & RA Woollacott of Yarnscombe for their pen of 58.6kg lambs, the same vendor had further pens of 55.6kg lambs to £174.00, 54.1kg lambs to £173.50 and 53.7kg lambs to £166.00. Messrs Lucas & Ridge of Chulmleigh saw their pen of 8 57.3kg lambs to £180.00. £175.00 was seen twice this week, firstly for Mr JO Yabsley of Witheridge for his pen of 58kg lambs and secondly for Messrs AT Tarr & Son of South Molton for their pen of 61kg lambs, Mr Yabsley had further pens of 51kg lambs to £161.00 and 53kg lambs to £155.00. Mr A Lawler of Nomansland saw his pen of 54kg lambs to £167.00 and a further pen of 49.1kg lambs to £154.50. £160.50 was seen for Mr D Fergie of Ash Mill for his pen of 54.6kg lambs and £152.00 for a pen of 49.7kg lambs. Messrs W Moore & Son of Rackenford saw their pen of 49kg lambs to £153.00. Mr JK May of Eastleigh saw his pen of 49.9kg lambs to £151.00. £150.00 was seen for Mr FC Reed of North Molton for his pen of 24 52.2kg lambs. £149.50 was seen for both Messrs Lucas & Ridge of Chulmleigh for their pen of 48kg lambs and for Messrs Irwin & Sons of Mariansleigh for their pen of 50.3kg lambs.

Top Pence Per Kilo in the lambs sales this week was seen for Messrs DJ & RA Woollacott of Yarnscombe for their pen of 54.1kg lambs which achieved 321ppk, the same vendor saw further pens of 55.6kg lambs achieve 314ppk and 58.6kg lambs reach 312ppk. 316ppk was seen for Mr JO Yabsley of Witheridge for his pen of 51kg lambs. Mr A Lawler of Nomansland saw his pen of 49.1kg lambs achieve 315ppk and a further pen of 45.6kg lambs to 310ppk. 314ppk was seen for Messrs Lucas & Ridge of Chulmleigh for their pen of 57.3kg lambs, the same vendor had a further pen of 48kg lambs to 311ppk. Mr R Trenaman of Colleton saw his pen of 42kg lambs reach 313ppk. 312ppk was seen for Messrs W Moore & Sons of Rackenford for their pen of 49kg lambs. 310ppk was seen three times this week, firstly for Mr R Greed of North Molton for his pen of 44.7kg lambs, secondly for Mr SJ Bale of Challacombe for his pen of 43.1kg lambs and thirdly for Mr NT Gear of Newton Tracey for his pen of 42kg lambs.

CULL EWES & RAMS (111)

As with the lamb numbers very short and a very mixed entry with a number of lean ewes on offer. Trade dearer than last week which was helped by the low number forward and a good number of buyers around the ring looking for ewes. All types of ewes dearer this week and generally up £5 per head on last week. Best Suffolk mules this week £125 plus and best Mules this week £110 plus.

Top call in the ewe sale this week was for Mr Barry Nicholls of Parracombe for his Bluefaced Leicester ewe which achieved £139.00.

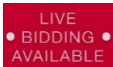
