**SOUTH MOLTON LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT  
26TH SEPTEMBER 2024  
1533 SHEEP SOLD  
1158 PRIME LAMBS, 81 STORE SHEEP & 294 CULL EWES & RAMS**

**PRIME LAMBS (1158)**

A much bigger number entry this week and overall a decent quality entry forward. As with last weeks it is those well fed 'meat' lambs that are most sought after and selling over the 300ppk mark and those leaner lambs selling around the 280ppk mark. Trade very similar to last week. Abattoirs want to be buying the lambs at less money as the sales remain very steady but the lower numbers nationally are keeping the trade firm. More leaner lambs forward this week which again well wanted and a touch dearer than last week.

*Topping the market this week was Mr AJ Avery of Yarnscombe with his pen of 68kg lambs achieving £192.80.* £187.00 was seen for Mr G Mills & Partners of Witheridge for their pen of 61.6kg lambs, the same vendor had a further notable pen of 58.7kg lambs to £182.00. Mr W Smale of North Molton saw his pen of 59.5kg lambs to £183.00 and a further pen of 55kg lambs to £167.50. £180.00 was seen for Miss AJ Felce of Bideford for her pen of 59.2kg lambs. Messrs PJ & BJ Millman of Chulmleigh saw their pen of 57.5kg lambs achieve £176.00. £172.50 was seen for Messrs RJ & AD Nicholls of West Anstey for their pen of 58.5kg lambs. Messrs RR & J Symons of South Molton achieved £167.00 for their pen of 55.8kg lambs. £166.50 was seen for Messrs Parsonage farm for their 55.3kg lambs. Messrs MH, CB & PM Ayre of Black Dog saw their pen of 56.6kg lambs to £165.50. £164.50 was seen twice this week, firstly for Mr AR Bater of Chittlehamholt for his pen of 56kg lambs and secondly for Mr JH Brown of Winsford for his pen of 55.7kg lambs. Messrs Irwin & Sons of Mariansleigh saw their pen of 54kg lambs to £164.00.

*Top Pence Per Kilo in the lamb sales this week was seen for both Messrs J & H Searle of Ash Mill for their pen of 46kg lambs and also for Mr SJ Bale of Chal-lacombe for his pen of 43kg lambs achieving 313ppk.* 312ppk was seen for Mr RC Huxtable Ltd of Bickleton for his pen of 38.5kg lambs. 310ppk was seen twice this week, firstly for Mr G Mills & Partners of Wither-

idge for their pen of 38.5kg lambs and secondly for Mr R Irwin of Kings Nympton for his pen of 47kg lambs. Mr JHR Hooper of Okehampton achieved 309ppk for his pen of 39.1kg lambs. 308ppk was achieved by Mr W Smale of North Molton for his pen of 59.5kg lambs. Messrs Parsonage Farms of Chulmleigh saw their pen of 45.4kg lambs achieve 307ppk. 306ppk was seen three times this week firstly for Messrs PJ & BJ Millman of Chulmleigh for their pen of 57.5kg lambs, secondly for Mr G Mills & Partners of Witheridge for their pen of 53.1kg lambs and lastly for Messrs RD Middleton & Son of Chulmleigh for their pen of 45.4kg lambs.

**STORE LAMBS (81)**

A smaller entry for our opening fortnightly sale of store lamb, with a trade that could have seen many sold. Several new faces around the ring looking for all grades of store lambs with many more wanted in a fortnights time.

*Top call in the store lamb sales this week was Mr J Ford of Instow for his pen of 22 store lambs achieving £101.00.* Messrs SS & D Wilson of Bish Mill saw their pens of store lambs to £98.50 and £92.50. Miss H Wilson of Bish Mill achieved £89.00 for her pen.

**CULL EWES & RAMS (294)**

More numbers forward this week and overall more bigger ewes on offer. Trade similar to last week and probably a fraction back on last week. Overall the bigger ewes were still wanted but back £3-5 per head on the week with the bigger Mule ewes back £10 per head. The medium and grazing ewes would be similar money to last week. A number of very small and very lean ewes in the average which remain difficult to sell and low money. Best Suffolk Mules this week £115 plus and best Mules this week £95 plus.

*Top call in the ewe sale this week was Mr NA Cooke of Torrington for his Texel ewe which reached £150.00.* £138.00 was seen for Messrs RJ & AD Nicholls of West Anstey for their pen of Suffolk ewes. Mr J Ware of Muddiford achieved £124.00 for his ewe. £119.00 was seen for Messrs C & DR Nicholas of Marwood for his ewes. Mr JH Brown of Winsford saw his pen of Suffolk ewes achieve £118.00.
