NEW SEASON LAMBS (1742)

Biggest number entry for quite a while this week with trade expected to be strong in front of the Qurbani Festival. Again a really decent show of lambs with a number of quality runs forward. Trade has dropped as the week has progressed as abattoirs killed all the festival and export orders early in the week. Trade back on last week which was disappointing having started the week so strong. Extraordinarily difficult to predict what trade will be like next week as numbers coming forward will surely ease but demand unlikely to be very strong either. Most lambs this week back around £5-8 per head with the 41-44kg lambs generally around 320ppk mark and the 45-46kg lambs more like 310ppk. Some of the well fed heavy lambs were a bit more sought after this week and actually a similar trade to last week.

Top call in the new season lamb sales this week was seen for Messrs Hill Farm Partnership of Bideford for their pen of 50.1kg lambs achieving £165.00. £161.00 was seen for Mr SJ Bale of Challacombe for his pen of 50kg lambs. Messrs PJ & BJ Millman of Chulmleigh saw their pen of 49kg lambs to £160.00. £159.00 was seen for Messrs AE Chudley & Son of Romansleigh for their pen of 58kg lambs.
