NEW SEASON LAMBS (1168)

A bigger number entry this week which was very pleasing considering the glorious hot weather and most farmers having grass down. Overall another good quality entry with some good runs of young lambs forward. Trade dearer again on the week and actually dearer than expected with all buyers very keen to secure lambs. Best trade this week for the heavier lambs (over 45kgs) but overall all weights were dearer on the week. A lot of the 45-47kgs lambs were sold in excess of 355ppk (over £160 per head). The very heavy lambs (over 55kgs) were much more sought after this week with lots of pens over the £180 mark. Very difficult to know whether the trade will hold into next week as it has become so variable week to week.

Topping the market this week was seen for Mr MD Parkin of Berynarbour for his pen of 56.6kg lambs achieving £199.50. £199.00 was seen for Mr MD Leworthy of Kentisbury for his pen of 58kg lambs. Mr JK May of Eastleigh saw his pen of 53kg lambs achieve £195.50. £195.00 was seen for Mr RF Rawle of Parracombe for his pen of 70.6kg lambs. £192.00 was seen three times this week, firstly for Messrs AW Fisher & Son of Oakford for their pen of 61kg lambs, secondly for Messrs WJ Woollacott & Sons of Bishops Nympton for their pen of 63kg lambs and thirdly for Messrs A & S Hoskin of Bishops Nympton for their pen of 64kg lambs. £188.00 was seen twice this week, firstly for Mr JK May of Eastleigh for his pen of 50kg lambs and secondly for Mr MD Leworthy of Kentisbury for his pen of 53kg lambs.
