A lesser number entry this week and overall a decent quality entry with more stronger heavier lambs forward this week. Trade has firmed this week due to lesser numbers coming forward nationally, with trade up over 10ppk on the week. The heavy lambs (over 52kgs) were markedly dearer this week with most pens up over £10 per head. The 48-52kgs lambs and the medium weight lambs, 43-47kgs, were up £5 per head. A lot less lighter lambs forward this week which were also dearer than previous weeks.

Topping the market this week was seen for Messrs DJ & RA Woolcott of Yarnscombe for their pen of 64kg lambs achieving £199.50. The same vendor had a further run of lambs reach £190.50 for a pen of 58.7kg lambs, £189.50 for a pen of 58.1kg lambs, £187.50 for a pen of 58.8kg lambs and £186.00 for a pen of 57.7kg lambs. £185.50 was seen for Mr K Harris of North Molton for his pen of 58kg lambs. Messrs PJ & BJ Millman of Chulmleigh saw their pen of 58.5kg lambs to £183.50. £183.00 was seen for Messrs A & S Hoskin of Bishops Nympton for their pen of 57kg lambs. Messrs IFJ & JC Harris of Sheepwash saw their pen of 57kg lambs to £182.50. £182.00 was seen for Mr R Irwin of Kings Nympton for his pen of 64kg lambs.

Topping the Pence Per Kilo this week was seen for Messrs M Tester & S Edwards of East Anstey for their pen of 42kg lambs achieving 343ppk. 333ppk was seen for Messrs Lucas & Ridge of Chulmleigh for their pen of 43.6kg lambs.
