A much reduced entry but no doubt a dearer trade with all clean hogs wanted.

Topping the prime hogg sales this week was seen for Messrs RT & HD Kingdon for their pen of 72kg hogs achieving £248.00.

Messrs GC Thomas & Son of Burrington saw their pen of 66kg hogs to £243.00. £241.00 was seen for Mr NJ Sharland of Knowle for his pen of 60kg hogs.

A smaller number entry compared to last weeks large pre festival entry. Again a decent quality entry with some lovely runs of young sappy well bred lambs. Trade was expected to be 'steadier' following the end of the festival but was actually a touch dearer with a number of buyers very keen to secure lambs at the end of this week who originally thought that they had enough. The strong trade was seen for all weights and again not many over 50kgs lambs forward. It looks likely that the lambs will continue to be wanted next week especially as the hogg numbers have all but dried up in the South West. The 40-44kgs lambs very wanted with most pens selling between £188-£210. The majority of the 45-50kg lambs were all £200-£216.

Topping the new season lamb sales this week was seen for Messrs J & J Rendle of Oakford for their pen of 61kg lambs achieving £222.00, the same vendor had a further pen of 47.50kg lambs to £208.00. £220.00 was seen for Messrs A Mogford of Nomansland for their pen of 56kg lambs. £215.00 was seen twice, firstly for Messrs TJ & JC Pincombe of Chulmleigh for their pen of 53.3kg lambs and secondly for Messrs G & P Kivell of Chulmleigh for their pen of 56.6kg lambs. Messrs Parsonage Farms of Chulmleigh saw their pen of 48kg lambs to £211.00 as did Messrs AW & SA Meikle of Chulmleigh for their pen of 48kg lambs. Messrs AW & SA Meikle had a further pen of 44.6kg lambs to £209.50. £209.50 was also seen for Messrs AE Chudley & Son of Romansleigh for their pen of 47kg lambs. £208.50 was seen for Mrs N Newman of Lydeard St Lawrence for her pen of 48kg lambs.
