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**Rendells Newton Abbot Livestock Market Report
Sale of Cattle & Sheep on Wednesday 1st July 2026**



Rendells Auctioneers are extremely pleased to report a fantastic trade at the July Fair held at Newton Abbot Livestock Market on Wednesday 1st July. With a higher than anticipated number of entries forward from South Dartmoor, throughout South Devon & up from Cornwall the quality of the cattle created a buzz and brought buyers from all around to get properly stuck into them, and it was great to see so many old faces once again attending Newton Abbot market and supporting Rendells.

Prime Cattle Ring

A tested, non farm-assured Limousin cross Cow weighing 640kg sold to a massive 328ppkg at £2099.20

Store Cattle Ring

With a spectacular consignment of 18 twelve month old suckled calves coming up for Altarnun nr Launceston meeting a tremendous trade with the shapely Limousin cross steers selling at £1850 twice, £1810 twice, £1800 twice, £1715 & £1610 while the heifers sold to £1860, £1800 twice, £1610 five times and £1600 twice and £1500 making them something eye catching in the shed and making the vendors John & Lisa Balsdon travel home very happy.

Other top calls of the day were a pair of 24 month old South Devon steers from Frank & Sue Martin of Postbridge selling to £2230 and a bunch of young 8 month old South Devon cross steers from P&W Coaker of Widecombe in the Moor topping out at a fantastic £1560. South Devons once again at Newton Abbot sold strong with Simon Butcher of Corndon Farm, Ponsworthy sold a bunch of 14 month old South Devon steers to £1520 while a bunch of four 13 month old South Devon heifers from Frank & Sue Martin made £1420.

A very strong consignment of cattle from DR Woods of Aveton Gifford met a great trade for his 14 & 15 month old Angus cross and Simmental cross steers selling away to £1700 three times and £1600 twice while his Angus cross 14 & 15 month old heifers sold to £1660 seven times. Westdown Farm of Blackawton once again saw a great trade as his well grown and fed cattle were very sort after with a bunch of four 16 month old Holstien Friesian steers sold away to £1640 a British Blue cross 16 month old steer selling to £1750, a Montbéliarde cross 15 month old steer selling to £1720 and other Holstein Friesian steers ranging from 12 to 17 month old selling at £1420.

Sheep Pens

The sheep section saw more buyers and returning vendors to a trade that is now beginning to see the processors continually trying to erode prime deadweight prices and confidence. A consignment from M Evans of Dunsford sold to 378pp/kg £170 a head, 370pp/kg £174 a head while A Frazer sold her pens of lambs weighing 42 kg to £151 her other pens of 46kg at £165, while PJ Caunter of Totnes sold his many pens of lambs to £151 or 359pp/kg.

Cull ewes topped out to £162 for strong pen of Texel cross, £150 for a pen of nine Llyn cross ewes and a leaner Suffolk ewe at £120.
