NEW SEASON LAMBS (1,282)

A decent number entry this week and overall a more mixed quality entry forward than we have seen so far this season with plenty of lighter and leaner lambs forward. Trade was expected to be less this week with the hot weather on the continent slowing sales. Trade was as expected with the well fleshed stronger lambs generally over 390ppk. There remains a shortage of heavy (over 50kgs) lambs and they are selling to a premium with plenty of those pens over the £200 mark. The lighter and leaner lambs were harder than expected to sell and generally trading between 350-370ppk.

Topping the New Season Lamb Sales this week was seen for Mr S Stentiford of South Molton for his pen of 55kg lambs achieving £238.00 and for Messrs G & E Summers of Brushford for their pen of 60kg lambs. Mr S Stentiford had a further run of 54kg lambs to £231.00 and £229.00, a 57kg lamb to £224.00 and a pen of 50kg lambs to £217.00. £235.00 was seen for Messrs RH Dymond & Son of Croyde for their pen of 59kg lambs. Mr EJ Westaway of Newton Tracey saw his pen of 56kg lambs to £228.00. £222.00 was seen for Messrs DJ & RA Woollacott of Yarnscombe for their pen of 53.8kg lambs and £209.00 for a pen of 50.6kg lambs. £219.00 was seen for both Messrs J & J Rendle of Oakford for their pen of 61kg lambs and for Messrs J & H Searle of Ash Mill for their pen of 55kg lambs. Messrs Parsonage Farms of Chulmleigh saw their pen of 52.8kg lambs to £214.00. £209.50 was seen for Messrs FG & LA Nott of Meshaw for their pen of 50kg lambs. £207.00 was seen for Messrs MR & SL Badham of Parkham for their pen of 54kg lambs. £205.00 was seen for Mr JK May of Bideford for his pen of 52kg lambs.
