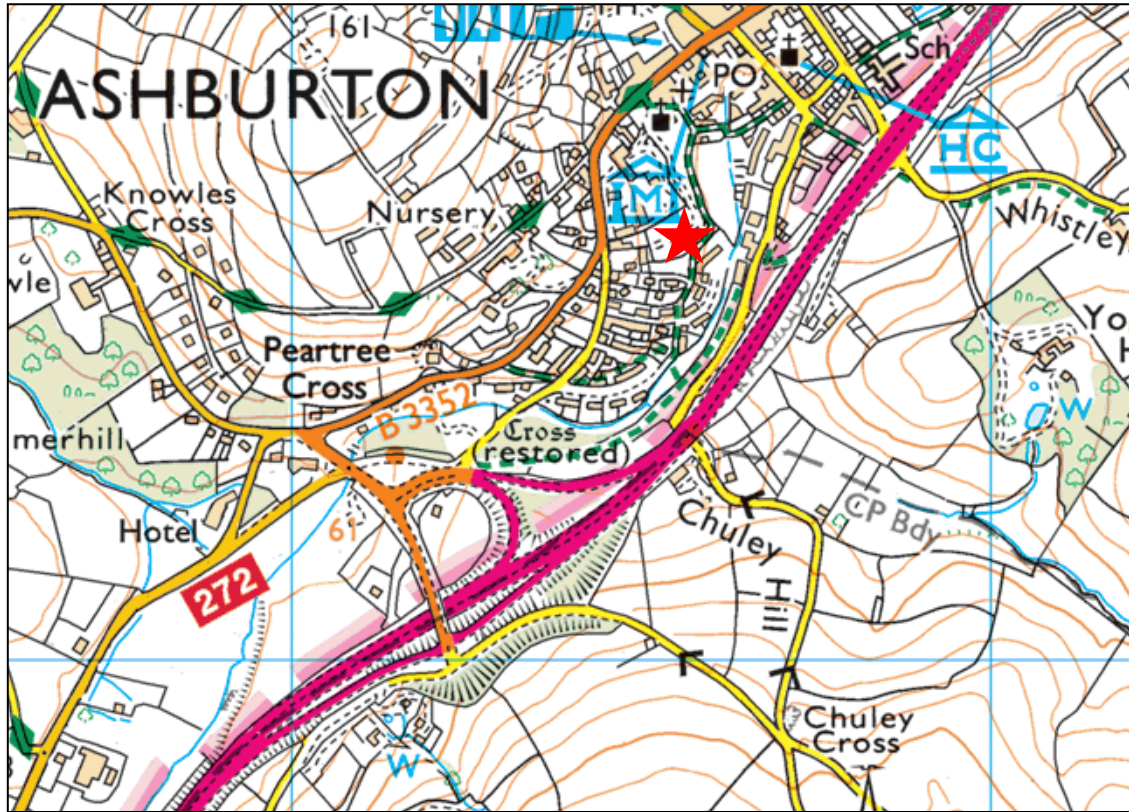

- d) "hammer price" means the level of bidding reached (at or above any reserve) when the auctioneer brings down the hammer;
- e) "terms of consignment" means the stipulated terms and rates of commission on which Rendells accepts instructions from sellers or their agent;
- f) "total amount due" means the hammer price in respect of the lot sold together with any premium, Value Added Tax chargeable and any other additional charges payable by a defaulting buyer under these Conditions;

- h) Any payment by you to us may be applied by us towards any sums owing from you to us on any account whatsoever without regard to any direction of you or your agent whether expressed or implied

32. Removal of Goods

- a) No purchase shall be claimed or removed until it has been paid for and the sale has concluded for that session. All purchases shall be paid for and removed at the purchaser's risk and expense by 17:00 on the Monday after the sale. - 16) “After...” In our opinion, a copy of a work by the artist.
- 17) The terms “signed”, and/or, “dated”, and/or, “inscribed”, means that in our opinion, the signature, and/or date, and/or inscription, are by the artist.
- 18) The terms “bears” a signature, and/or, “date”, and/or, “inscription”, means that in our opinion, the signature, date, and/or, inscription have been added by another hand.
- 19) Dimensions are given: Height X Width.
- 20) “a/f” Is in “as found” condition which includes but is not limited to fault, damage and decay.
