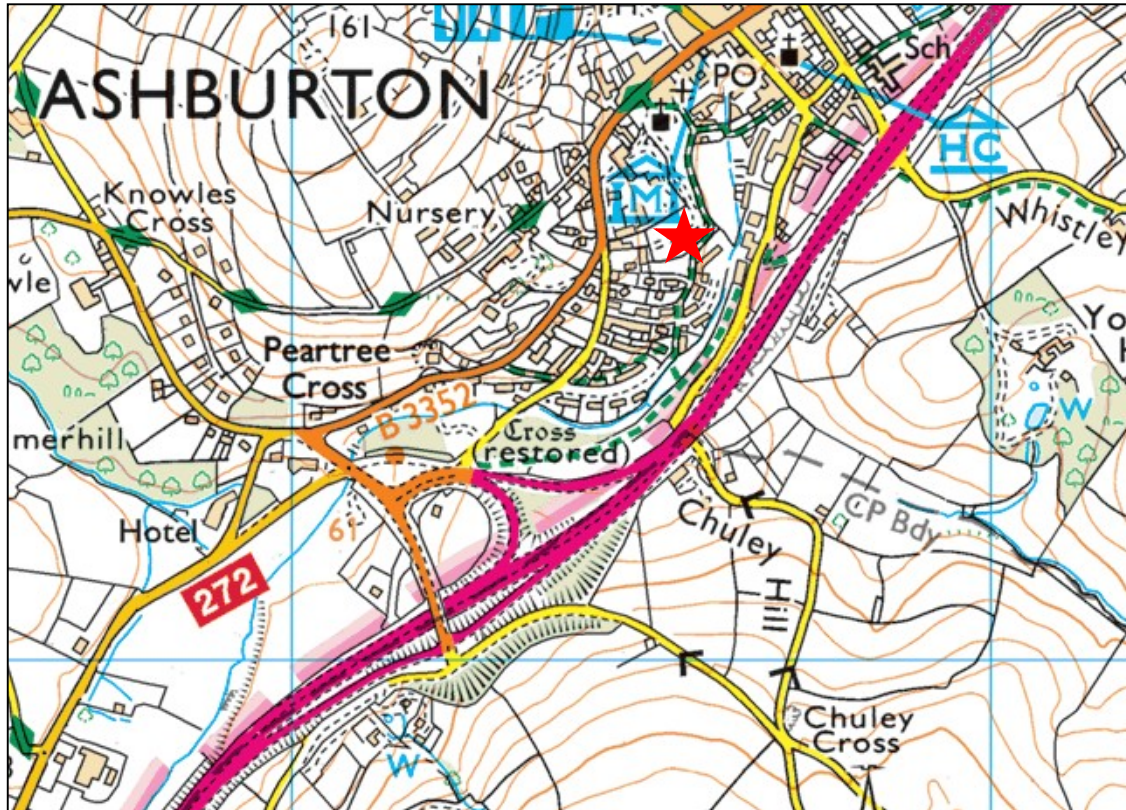

- c) "deliberate forgery" means an imitation made with the intention of deceiving as to authorship, origin, date, age, period, culture or source but which is unequivocally described in the catalogue as being the work of a particular creator and which at the date of sale had a value materially less than it would have had if it had been in accordance with the description;
- d) "hammer price" means the level of bidding reached (at or above any reserve) when the auctioneer brings down the hammer;
- e) "terms of consignment" means the stipulated terms and rates of commission on which Rendells accepts instructions from sellers or their agent;
- f) "total amount due" means the hammer price in respect of the lot sold together with any premium, Value Added Tax chargeable and any other additional charges payable by a defaulting buyer under these Conditions;

2. General

- b) Rendells do not accept responsibility for the authenticity attribution, genuineness, origin, authorship, date, age, period, condition or quality of any lot, unless they have been instructed in writing by the vendor so to certify, and in such case the Auctioneers do so as agents of the vendor and are not themselves responsible for such claims.
- c) All statements, whether printed in the catalogue or made orally, as to any of the matters set out in (b) above are statements of opinion only and are not to be taken as being or implying any warranties or representations of fact. Rendells unless they have been instructed in writing by the vendor so to certify and in such case the Auctioneers do so as agents of the vendor and are not themselves responsible for such claims.

In the event of a dispute then the matter shall be settled by arbitration, the arbitrator to be nominated by the President of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors. Both the Purchaser and the Vendor agree to be bound by the decision.

5. Default

11. Instructions

12. Commission

13. Lotting Fee

14. Reserves

15. Insurance

20. Prohibited, Restricted and Licensed items

If an item brought to the saleroom is found to be prohibited or restricted, we reserve the right to return this item to the owner, if allowed or to the relevant authority at the Vendors expense.

21. Collections

Items for sale must be consigned to the saleroom at the Vendors expense, we may be able to assist in making arrangements, but any costs of a carrier are your responsibility. Rendells disclaim all responsibility for loss or damage to goods or for unauthorised removal of goods and for damage to premises caused by the contractor who should be insured for such risks. Unless instructions are received to the contrary the charge for these services will be deducted from the proceeds of sale.

22. Withdrawals

Rendells reserve the right to charge the full sale commission based on reserves or pre-sale estimates plus any extra expenses on any goods which are entered, catalogued and withdrawn from sale, or a lesser amount at their discretion. The minimum charge is £25.00 + VAT (£30.00) per lot.

23. Settlement

After the sale settlement of the net sum due to you normally takes place within 10 working days of the sale unless the buyer has not paid for the good(s). In this case no settlement of the sale item will take place and we will take your instructions as to whether you would like the item re-offered or returned to you.

24. Deductions

The Vendor authorises the Auctioneer to deduct commission and expenses at the stated rate from the hammer price.

25. Indemnity

a) The vendor shall duly indemnify Rendells against any claims in connection with any goods sold by Rendells on the vendor's behalf and will warrant that the goods are his or her bona fide items to sell and are not subject to any Hire Purchase Agreement, Lease or Loan Arrangement and if they have the authority to sell.

b) In the case of deceased estates and power of attorney's we will require written/photographic evidence of the Vendors authority to sell the items.

26. Value Added Tax

c) To clarify, live webcast auctions are NOT sales governed by Distance Selling Regulations – all lots are available to be viewed prior to the sale.

28. Bidding Procedures and the Purchaser

a) All prospective purchasers are required to register their full name and address at the auction office before bidding and to satisfy any security arrangements before entering the auction room to view or bid.

b) Every bidder shall be deemed to act as principal unless there is in force a written acknowledgement by Rendells that he acts as agent on behalf of a named principal, no transfer will be accepted.

c) The highest approved bidder shall be the purchaser and if any dispute arises as to who was the last or highest bidder the Auctioneer has sole discretion to withdraw the lot and re-offer it by auction to settle the dispute.

d) Once made, no bid may be withdrawn

e) Bidding increments shall be at the auctioneer's sole discretion.

f) The minimum starting bid is £5.

29. Purchase Price

a) The Purchaser shall pay the hammer price, VAT where applicable, together with **Buyers Premium of 20% + VAT (24%)** on each lot.

b) Any lot purchased via Easy Live Auction is subject to an additional 3% + VAT (27.6% total) via free registration will apply on the hammer price or if the 'flat fee' registration is chosen the standard 24% will apply on the hammer price.

30. Value Added Tax

a) Any lot where VAT at 20% is payable will be marked with an *.

b) VAT is likely because the seller is registered for VAT within the European Union and is not operating the Dealers Margin Scheme or because VAT is due at 20% on importation to the U.K.

c) The ** indicates the lot has been imported from outside of the European Union and the present position is that these lots are liable to a reduced rate of VAT (5.00%) on the hammer price and 20% on the buyer's premium.

d) Lots which appear without either of these symbols indicate that no VAT is payable on the hammer price.

31. Payment

- g) We do not accept American Express
- h) Any payment by you to us may be applied by us towards any sums owing from you to us on any account whatsoever without regard to any direction of you or your agent whether expressed or implied

32. Removal of Goods

- a) No purchase shall be claimed or removed until it has been paid for and the sale has concluded for that session. All purchases shall be paid for and removed at the purchaser's risk and expense by 17:00 on the Monday after the sale. All lots not so removed shall remain at the risk of the purchaser subject to a minimum storage charge of £2.00 + VAT (£2.40) per day and if they are not paid for and removed within seven days of the sale the Auctioneer may re-sell them by auction or privately without notice to the purchaser. Any liability which there may be on the part of the Auctioneer in respect of any loss shall be restricted to a maximum of the price paid by the purchaser of the lot.
- b) In the event of any failure of the purchasers to comply with any of the above conditions the damages recoverable by the seller or the Auctioneers from the defaulters shall include any loss arising on any re-sale of the lot, together with the charges and expenses in respect of both sales, and together with interest at **5% above Lloyds Bank PLC Base Rate** upon the price of any lot which has not been paid for within 48 hours of the sale, and any money deposited in part payment shall be held by the Auctioneers on account of any liability of the defaulter to them or to the seller.

We will not pack china, glass, pictures or any prohibited items as stated by the Royal Mail. We take care in the packing of items, but Rendells will not accept liability for any damage caused in transit. The consignee accepts this as part of our terms of dispatch and is solely responsible for insuring the goods against any loss or damage.

34. Notes for Remote Buyers

Items paid for with Debit or Credit Card where the purchaser wants the items posted will only be released by Rendells if the delivery address of the consignee is the same as in our records and the registered address of the purchaser's card. If the invoice and delivery addresses are different then the purchaser will be required to make payment by bank transfer which must be cleared before the goods are released. If the purchaser arranges their own transport or courier and they want the items delivered to another address they must inform Rendells in writing prior to collection.

35. Telephone Bidding

Prospective buyers are strongly advised to attend the auction and are responsible for any decision to bid for a particular Lot and shall be assumed to have carefully inspected and satisfied themselves as to its condition. We will if so, instructed by prior arrangement, arrange a telephone bid with a telephone line booked on single or multiple lots. A member of staff will call you from the Saleroom just before your lot number is offered for sale and you can then instruct us on a live telephone line to bid or to stop on your behalf. We always ask that you leave us a main telephone number and a backup number in case of difficulties contacting you. It is always recommended that a covering bid be left in the unfortunate event that we are unable to make contact. All telephone lines must be booked with us no later than 17:00 the day before the two-day sale commences. Rendells require any telephone bidder to provide two forms of identification (including photographic ID).

36. Commission Bids

While prospective buyers are strongly advised to attend the auction and are always responsible for any decision to bid for a particular Lot and shall be assumed to have carefully inspected and satisfied themselves as to its condition, we will if so, instructed clearly and in writing execute bids on their behalf. Neither the auctioneer nor our employees or agents shall be responsible for any neglect or default in so doing or failing to do so. Where two or more commission bids at the same level are recorded, we reserve the right in our absolute discretion to prefer the first bid so made. Rendells require any commission bidder to provide two forms of identification (including photographic ID). All commission bids to be with us no later than 09:30 on the morning of the sale.

37. Artist Resale Right Regulations 2012 (“Droit de Suite”)

- a) Subject to specific conditions, some works of art by Artists (living or deceased in the last seventy years) and sold over the equivalent of £1000 the purchaser is liable to pay an additional resale royalty. Any lot which may be liable will be marked with a †.
- b) The amount is capped at £12,500 per lot.
- c) The amount is calculated as follows;
Royalty for the portion of the hammer price (in pound sterling) 4.00% up to £50,000
Royalty for the portion of the hammer price (in pound sterling) 3.00% between £50,000.01 to £200,000
Royalty for the portion of the hammer price (in pound sterling) 1.00% between £200,000.01 to £350,000
Royalty for the portion of the hammer price (in pound sterling) 0.50% between £350,000.01 to £500,000
Royalty for the portion of the hammer price (in pound sterling) 0.25% in excess of £500,000
- d) Invoices will, as usual, be issued in Pounds Sterling

38. Electrical Goods

Any electrical goods sold without a PAT's label are sold as antiques only. If an electrical item has a PAT's label it does not mean it is working only that the item is safe.

39. Property and Risk

Legal title will not pass to the purchaser until the lot(s) has/have been paid for in full and the Auctioneers shall be entitled to a lien on any lot sold until the purchase price (as defined in 28 above) is paid in full but each lot is at the sole risk of the buyer from the fall of the hammer. Each purchaser shall forthwith give his full names and permanent address and when called upon to do so by the Auctioneer shall forthwith pay to Rendells the purchase price as the Auctioneer may require. If the buyer fails to do so, the lot may at the Auctioneer's sole discretion be put up again and re-sold.

40. General Notes

- c) If we are found to be liable to you for any reason (including if we are found to be negligent, in breach of contract or to have media misrepresentation) our liability is limited to the total purchase price paid by you for any lot.

- 15) “Manner of...” In our opinion, a work in the style of the artist, but of a later date.
- 16) “After...” In our opinion, a copy of a work by the artist.
- 17) The terms “signed”, and/or, “dated”, and/or, “inscribed”, means that in our opinion, the signature, and/or date, and/or inscription, are by the artist.
- 18) The terms “bears” a signature, and/or, “date”, and/or, “inscription”, means that in our opinion, the signature, date, and/or, inscription have been added by another hand.
- 19) Dimensions are given: Height X Width.
- 20) “a/f” Is in “as found” condition which includes but is not limited to fault, damage and decay.
